Dear Fathers, Deacons, Parish Directors, Lay Leaders/Business Administrators, Sisters and Staff,

The Chancery received word that **REV. HUGH JOSEPH BRIODY**, age 85 years, died Easter Sunday, April 21, 2019, at St. Francis Hospice in Blanchardstown, Ireland. **FR. HUGH** was born in Shanco, Killallon, County Meath, Ireland and attended Benburb Servite Priory, Ireland and Servite International College, Rome. **FR. HUGH** was ordained to the Sacred Order of the Priesthood in the Church of San Marcello, Rome on April 15, 1963.

In 1968, **FR. HUGH** was welcomed into the Diocese of Superior, WI and was appointed Assistant Pastor of the Cathedral of Christ the King, Superior. In 1969, **FR. HUGH** requested a return to the Servite Order but after further discernment, it was decided that he would be incardinated into the Diocese of Superior, in December 1971.
