From the Deacon's Bench

Brothers and Sisters,

On Monday, we received the following statement from the Bishops of Indiana:

“While commending our pastors and parish life coordinators who have gone to great lengths to assure safe worship spaces in our churches, due to the increase in the COVID-19 cases in our state, the Indiana bishops have decided to extend the dispensation from the obligation of Sunday Mass attendance beyond August 15 until November 1, 2020, unless further developments determine otherwise.”

So, I thank those who have chosen to return to Mass, and I also thank those who have chosen not to return yet. These are difficult times, and each of us must make our own decision as to when we will be ready to venture back out to Mass. Each of us needs to weigh our own concerns based on our knowledge of our own health. When we have done so, then we can own our decision.

Our bishops wisely recognize this and, given the continued growth in the number of cases and deaths, the bishops have removed any concerns or obligation that might stand in the way of each of us making our own decision in good conscience.

Let us continue to pray for those stricken with the virus and for those who care for them. Let us also pray that we will soon all be able to gather again, safely as a community.
