



### A Few Historical Notes:

In July of 1946, St. Andrew the Apostle Parish was created.

Fr. Matthew Herold was designated as the first pastor. The gold chalice we use on holy days and during the Christmas and Easter seasons was left to the parish by Fr. Herold.

On September 12, 1948, the school building was dedicated with Mass in the gym.

In our 75 years as a parish, we have worshiped in three locations on campus: the school gymnasium (1948 -1962), the social hall (1962- 1976), and our present church (1976 – now).
