FROM THE DESK OF FATHER PAVINO

St. Peter Church is a Roman Catholic community, evangelizing by the power of the Holy Spirit, leading others to a joyful encounter with Christ and experiencing Our Father's merciful love.

The Mission and Vision Statement of our Parish invites us to look back at the Covenant made by God with Abraham. "I will be your God and you shall be my people" (Gen. 17:7) The Covenant established a relationship between God and man. This relationship was a type of family affiliation wherein everyone is significant. This is the Church that Jesus Christ founded, a community of believers treating each other as family.

The guiding principle of the Church that Jesus Christ established is the Gospel – which in Greek is called evangelion. As a community of believers, we greatly cling to the Gospel truths. Our faith is a faith that seeks understanding. Understanding that leads us to appreciate and recognize our calling to be like Christ. We are challenged to live the Gospel ... to promote the Gospel ... and to defend the Gospel.

The loving mercy of God which was accomplished through the Paschal Mystery of Christ gave us the guarantee of our eternal reward in heaven.
