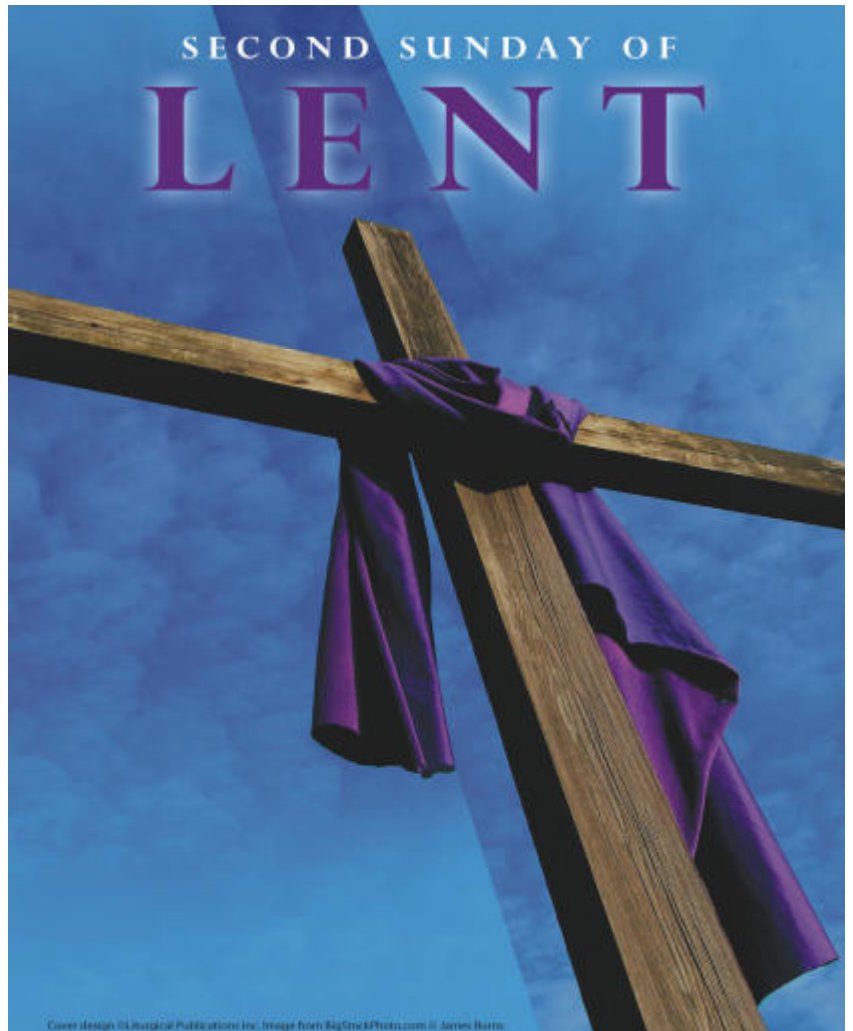

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER PAVINO

St. Peter was chosen by Jesus Christ to lead the Apostles and to be the head of the Church He established. Definitely this was a great task for Peter. After the resurrection, our risen Lord entrusted to Peter the care of His flock, Jesus said: "feed my sheep..." (John 21:15-19).

At first glance, one would think that Peter does not qualify to be the head and leader of the Church. He was aggressive yet careless. He did not calculate things. He was overly eager but at the first sign of danger he would shrink. This was demonstrated on the wall painting in the Church narthex. The painting was inspired by the story in the Gospel according to Matthew 14:22-33. When Peter saw Jesus walking on water, Peter immediately told Jesus: "Lord, if it is you, bid me come to you on water." Peter got what he asked for but as soon as he felt the cold water under his feet, he started sinking. Peter faltered ... he doubted the Lord.

Another instance that showed Peter's shortcoming was when Jesus was arrested and brought to the Sanhedrin. Peter secretly followed Jesus to where He would be interrogated, and some people recognized Peter. They asked him whether he was one of the Disciples of Christ. Peter denied it, not once but three times. Again, this clearly showed that Peter was not fit to become the head of the Church, at least according to our standards- to human standards. Still, the fact remains. Peter was chosen by Christ to be the head of the Church He established.

What then was that outstanding character of Peter that Jesus saw that made Him choose Peter to become the leader of the Church? The answer: It was his FAITH.

In the Gospel according to Matthew 16:13-19, Jesus asked His disciples who did they think He was. It was Peter who answered: YOU ARE THE MESSIAH. After Peter made his confession of faith, Jesus established His Church, giving Peter the authority to be the head and leader of the Church. He became the "rock" upon whom the Church was built.

Our Church, the parish of South Beloit is fortunate to have St. Peter as our PATRON SAINT. St. Peter, without a doubt is looking on us from heaven. St. Peter, as our patron saint intercedes for us. In some ways, we are like St. Peter - we are flawed and possessing many limitations and yet, we have strong faith in Jesus Christ. What happened to Peter explains how God looks at us. God does not look at what we are today but, God looks at our potential. God sees our potential and gives us opportunities and chances to realize our potential. To God we are all potential saints ...

El amor al prójimo es el FRUTO de nuestro amor a Dios.

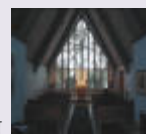
