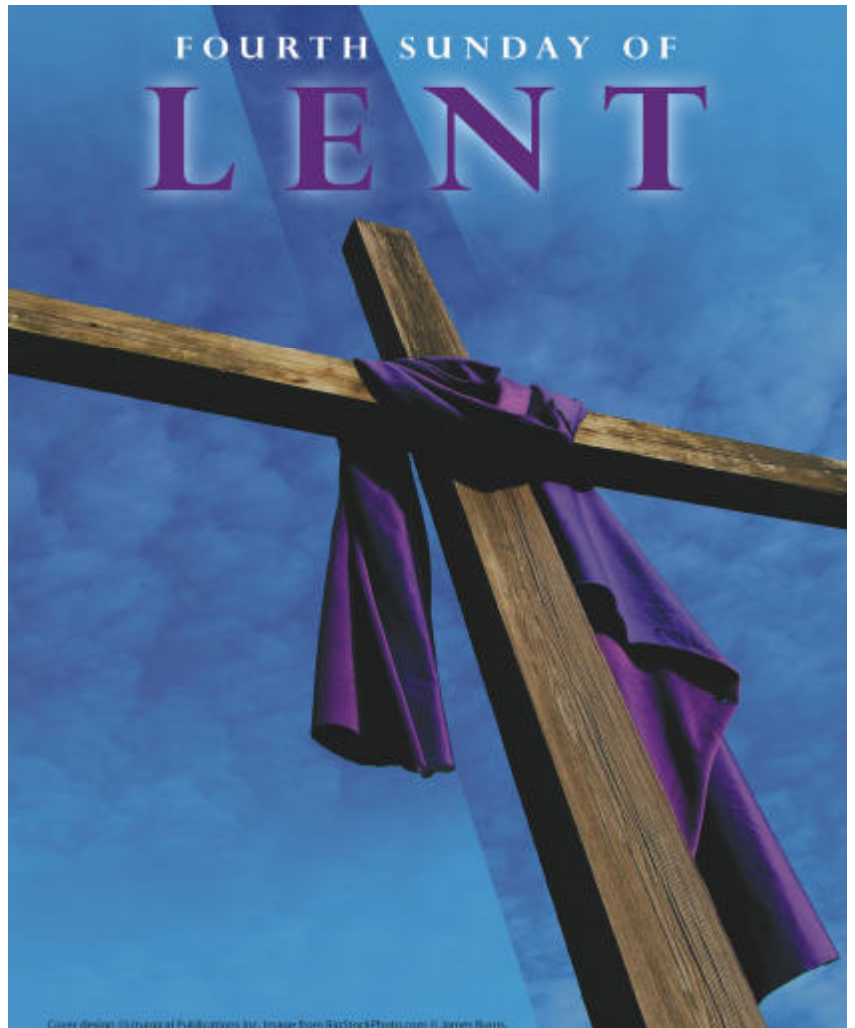

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER PAVINO

We are now midway of the season of Lent. It makes us more eager to celebrate the greatest Christian feast – the PASCHAL TRIDUUM. The 3 day celebration of the Paschal event – the passion, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ, which starts on Holy Thursday and culminates with the celebration of the Easter Vigil.

It is important for us to understand that the passion, death and resurrection of Christ, although they are 3 separate events, must not be taken independently. They are one PASCHAL EVENT – the one redemptive action of our Lord Jesus Christ that wrought our salvation. There will be no resurrection without the passion and death, and the passion and death are the way to obtain new life that is the resurrection.

There are people who put so much emphasis on the passion and death of Christ, that they focus on Good Friday. They became imprisoned on the reality of suffering in the world, so much so that they no longer see that there is still hope. On the other hand, there are people who love so much the triumph of the resurrection that they put too much accent on the glory and happiness it brings. In doing so they no longer see the significance of suffering and hardships.

As Christian Catholics, we must always have a holistic view of our faith. We can show this by being aware of our responsibility to partake in the 3 day celebration of the Paschal Triduum. The celebration which starts on Holy Thursday is a continuous celebration that will end on Easter Vigil. We cannot attend Holy Thursday and then miss Good Friday, or attend Good Friday and miss the Easter Vigil, or just attend the Easter Vigil and miss Good Friday and Holy Thursday. We must not “compartmentalize,” we must not be satisfied with just fragments. We must enjoy the whole and not just the part or parts. What Jesus Christ offered to us is the FULLNESS OF SALVATION and not just a portion of salvation.

PADRE LOAIZA

AÑO DEDICADO A SAN JOSE

El Papa Francisco decretó un Año dedicado a San José desde el 8 de diciembre de 2020 hasta el 8 de diciembre de 2021, periodo en el que los católicos tendrán la oportunidad de obtener una indulgencia plenaria especial.

Según el decreto emitido por la Penitenciaría Apostólica, existen 15 formas de recibir una indulgencia en el Año de San José:

- 1) Participa en un retiro espiritual durante al menos un día que incluya una meditación sobre San José.
- 2) Pide en oración la intercesión de San José para que los desempleados puedan encontrar un trabajo digno.
- 3) Recita las Letanías de San José por los cristianos perseguidos. Los católicos bizantinos tienen la opción de recitar un Akathist para San José.
- 4) Encomienda el trabajo y las actividades diarias a la protección de San José Obrero.
- 5) Sigue el ejemplo de San José y realiza una obra de misericordia corporal como dar de comer al hambriento, dar de beber al sediento, vestir al desnudo, dar posada al peregrino, visitar a los presos y los enfermos y enterrar a los difuntos.
- 6) Realiza una de las obras espirituales de misericordia, como consolar al triste, dar buen consejo al que lo necesita, enseñar al que no sabe, corregir al que se equivoca, sufrir con paciencia los defectos del prójimo, perdonar al que nos ofende y rezar por los vivos y los difuntos.
- 7 Reza el Rosario con tu familia para que “todas las familias cristianas se sientan estimuladas a recrear el mismo ambiente de íntima comunión, amor y oración que había en la Sagrada Familia”.
- 8) Las parejas comprometidas también pueden recibir una indulgencia al rezar el Rosario juntos.
- 9) Medita al menos 30 minutos al rezar el Padre Nuestro, pues San José “nos invita a redescubrir nuestra relación filial con el Padre, a renovar la fidelidad a la oración, a escuchar y corresponder con profundo discernimiento a la voluntad de Dios”.
- 10) Reza una oración aprobada a San José el domingo de San José, que es el domingo después de Navidad en la tradición católica bizantina.
- 11) Celebra la fiesta de San José el 19 de marzo realizando un acto de piedad en honor a San José.
- 12) Reza una oración aprobada a San José el día 19 de cualquier mes.
- 13) Honra a San José realizando un acto de piedad o rezando una oración aprobada cualquier miércoles, el día tradicionalmente dedicado a San José.
- 14) Reza a San José en la Fiesta de la Sagrada Familia celebrada el 27 de diciembre.
- 15) Celebra la fiesta de San José Obrero el 1 de mayo realizando un acto de piedad u ofreciendo tu oración.
