FROM THE DESK OF FATHER PAVINO

The Lord is risen Alleluia!

The summit of our celebration of the Paschal Mystery of Christ is His resurrection. After sacrificing and offering His life for our salvation, He now emerged as a victor. Jesus Christ won over sin and death. The fall of Adam resulted in death. The resurrection of Jesus resulted in the restoration or giving back of that life that we lost due to sin. Let me again mention that the Paschal Mystery – the passion, death and resurrection of Christ is just a single event. It is the one redemptive act of Christ.

The term Paschal comes from the Hebrew word *pe-sach* which literally means to pass over. In the Book of Exodus, God decreed through Moses that the Israelites must annually celebrate their liberation from the bondage of slavery in Egypt. It was a commemoration of what had transpired during that fateful night when the Lord went through the whole of Egypt striking down every first born of the land. But those houses which were marked by the blood of the lamb, the Lord passed over them and spared their first born. This is the Passover feast of the Israelites, when the blood of the lamb saved their first born from death in Egypt.

The Passover feast of the Israelites reflects the Paschal Mystery of Christ. Just like how the blood of the lamb saved the Israelites, the Blood of Jesus – the Lamb of God redeemed all of humanity. The resurrection of Jesus demonstrates the passing over or crossing over from death to life. This is the profound meaning of our celebration. This is the meaning of our Easter celebration.

The challenge for us now is to live the message of Easter. We must make the crossing over from sin to a new life. We must be ready to leave our old selves and embrace the newness of life in Christ. Borrowing the words of St. Paul: IT IS NO LONGER I THAT LIVES IN ME BUT JESUS! (Gal. 2:20).

Have a Blessed Easter everyone! God bless you, Mama Mary loves you!

Resucito aleluya

Qué es Pascua (o Día de Pascua):

La Pascua celebra la resurrección de Jesucristo al tercer día después de haber sido crucificado, según se relata en el Nuevo Testamento de la Biblia. Es la celebración más importante de la Iglesia cristiana.

La Pascua es también conocida como Día de Pascua, Domingo de Pascua, Domingo de Resurrección, Domingo de Gloria o Domingo Santo.

Con la Pascua finaliza la Semana Santa, días en los que se conmemora la crucifixión y muerte de Jesús el Viernes Santo y se celebra su resurrección y aparición ante sus discípulos el Domingo de Pascua.

Con la Pascua inicia un periodo conocido como Tiempo Pascual, que dura cincuenta días, y que finaliza el Domingo de Pentecostés.

Según las Sagradas Escrituras, con la Pascua Dios da a los cristianos la esperanza por la resurrección y por una nueva forma de vida, representada en el regreso de Cristo de entre los muertos.

La Pascua es una fiesta móvil, cuyo día varía cada año. Esto se debe a que la fecha no es fijada siguiendo el calendario civil, sino por el año litúrgico, que se rige por los ciclos lunares.

Así, la Pascua se ubica siempre después de la primera luna llena luego del inicio de la primavera en el hemisferio norte, y del otoño, en el sur.

En este sentido, la Pascua puede celebrarse entre los días 22 de marzo y 25 de abril. Y el día en que esta cae es importante para calcular también las fechas de otras fiestas religiosas, como el Pentecostés y la Ascensión.

El término Pascua proviene del latín páscae, que a su vez proviene del griego πάσχα (pasua), una adaptación del hebreo פסח (pésaj), que significa "paso" o "salto".
