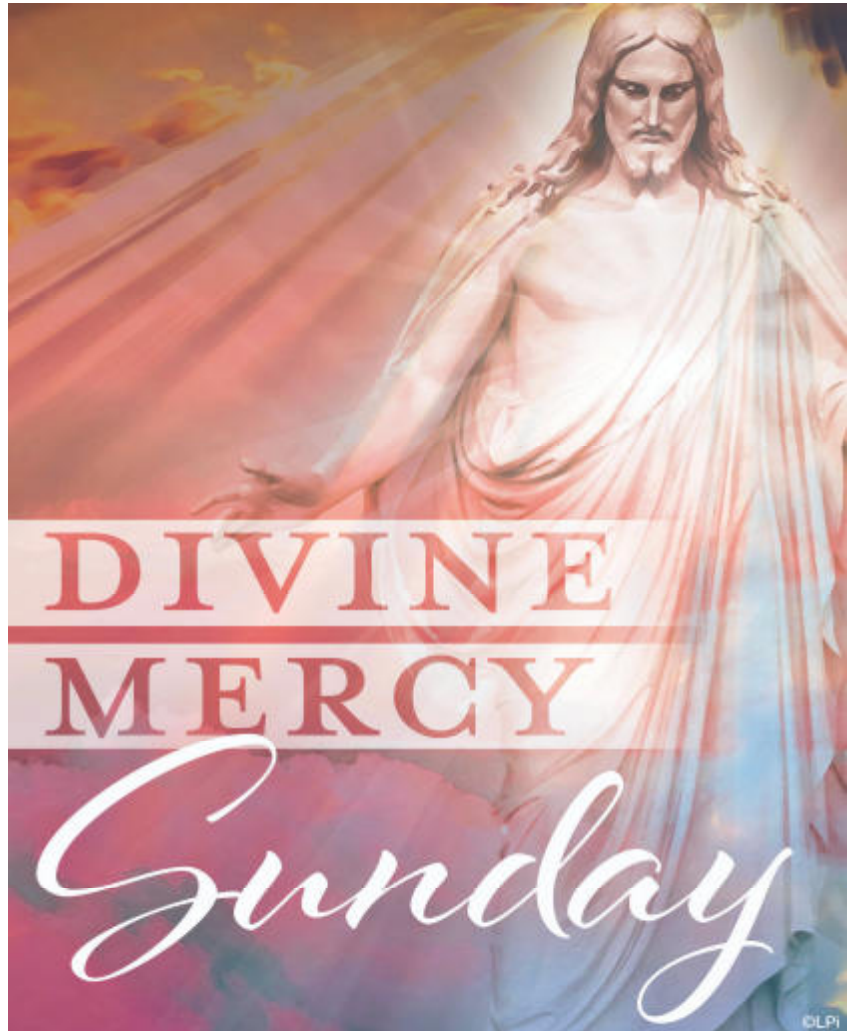

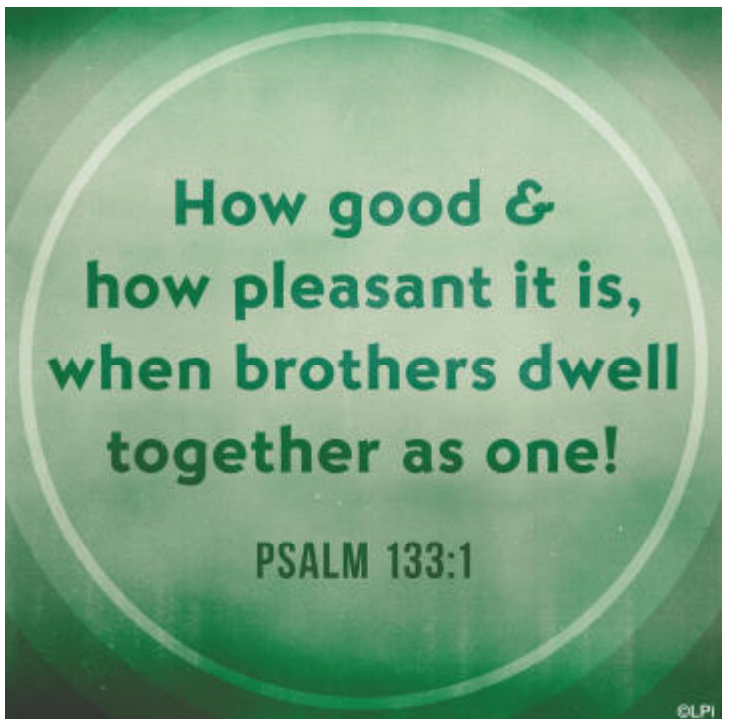

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER PAVINO

God indeed is full of mercy. Time and again, God has shown His loving mercy to us. The mercy of God is not a mere emotion for the sad plight of His people. His mercy is real and dynamic. God acts on His mercy. When God heard the cry of the Israelites when they wanted to be liberated from the bondage of slavery in Egypt, God demonstrated His mercy and sent Moses to set them free (Exodus 2:9). When Jesus saw the crowd following him, His heart was moved with pity for them, for they were like a sheep without a shepherd (Matthew 9:36). Coming to Jerusalem, Jesus saw that Jerusalem had turned its back to God and He wept over Jerusalem (Luke 19:41).

God ultimately demonstrated His DIVINE MERCY through Jesus Christ. Jesus gave up His life to save us from the bondage of sin and death. That act of sacrificing His life for us was anchored on God's LOVING MERCY. This is the love that Jesus preached. There is no greater love than laying down one's life for one's friend (John 15:13). This is SUPERABUNDANT LOVE. God has already done his part, He has already shown his love and mercy. Now let us do our part.

Divine Mercy is both a grace and a challenge, a responsibility. We must repay the goodness of God to us. The most concrete way to be a witness to the Divine Mercy is to be merciful ourselves, through the practice of charity. We do not have to do spectacular things rather, we must be loving and merciful above all in the ordinary events of daily life.

FIESTA DE LA DIVINA MISERICORDIA

Acerca de esta celebración

La devoción de la Divina Misericordia recibió un gran impulso en el pontificado de Juan Pablo II. El Papa proclamó la "Fiesta de la Divina Misericordia" el 30 de abril de 2000, que se celebraría todos los años el primer domingo después de Pascua.

Esta fiesta fue impulsada por la religiosa polaca Santa Faustina Kowalska. El 22 de febrero de 1931 tuvo una visión de Jesús, quien le encomendó tres cosas:

- Predicar la Misericordia de Dios.
- Elaborar nuevas formas de devoción.
- Iniciar un movimiento que renovara la vida de los cristianos en el espíritu de confianza y misericordia.

La esencia de la devoción:

1. Debemos confiar en la Misericordia del Señor.

Jesús, por medio de Sor Faustina nos dice: "Deseo conceder gracias inimaginables a las almas que confían en mi misericordia. Que se acerquen a ese mar de misericordia con gran confianza. Los pecadores obtendrán la justificación y los justos serán fortalecidos en el bien. Al que haya depositado su confianza en mi misericordia, en la hora de la muerte le colmaré el alma con mi paz divina".

2. La confianza es la esencia, el alma de esta devoción y a la vez la condición para recibir gracias.

"Las gracias de mi misericordia se toman con un solo recipiente y este es la confianza. Cuanto más confíe un alma, tanto más recibirá. Las almas que confían sin límites son mi gran consuelo y sobre ellas derramo todos los tesoros de mis gracias.

3. La misericordia define nuestra actitud ante cada persona. "Exijo de ti obras de misericordia que deben surgir del amor hacia mí. Debes mostrar misericordia siempre y en todas partes. No puedes dejar de hacerlo ni excusarte ni justificarte. Te doy tres formas de ejercer misericordia: la primera es la acción; la segunda, la palabra; y la tercera, la oración. En estas tres formas se encierra la plenitud de la misericordia y es un testimonio indefectible del amor hacia mí. De este modo el alma alaba y adora mi misericordia".
