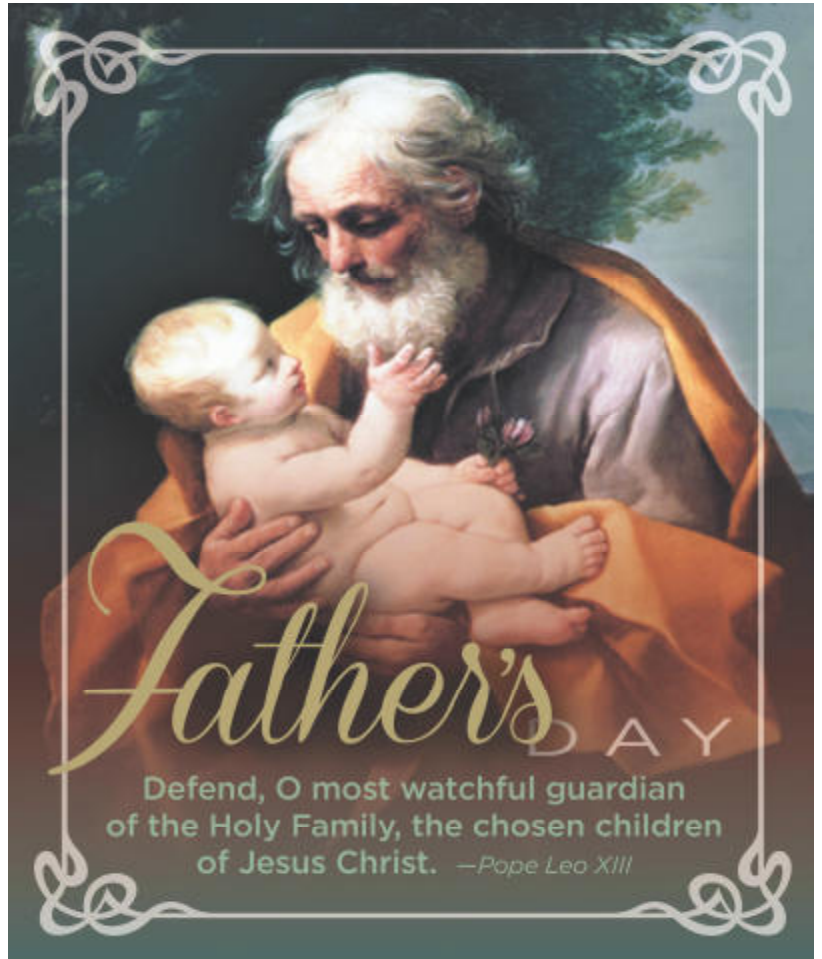

### FROM THE DESK OF FATHER PAVINO

Effective June 11, as per instructions from the Diocese, we are moving to Phase 5. Praise God! This is a day we have all been waiting for. And so, what does this mean for our parish. Everything goes back to normal ... almost.

These are some specifics of Phase 5:

- All indoor and outdoor sacramental and non-sacramental gatherings and activities will resume at full capacity.

- Holy Communion will now be distributed normally - meaning no separate lines separating the reception of Communion. Every line will have the option to receive either on the tongue or in the hand.

- Altar Servers, Greeters and Ushers will resume.

- The number of members singing in the Choir is no longer limited.

- The use of all of our holy water fonts will be restored back to normal.

- Because we do not have long-handled collection baskets, the collection basket will still be placed by the altar and you may put your envelopes in the basket during Communion time.

- In accord with Diocesan directives, we will continue to refrain from the communal exchange of the Sign of Peace.

- We will continue to clean, disinfect, and sanitize our facilities on a regular basis

- We may now use the basement for meetings and gatherings and food consumption is permitted at all gatherings and activities without restrictions.

- Food may be brought from home for consumption on parish premises for bake sales and funeral luncheons.

As I said, almost back to normal - a definite huge leap!

Thank you all so much for your patience, your faithfulness, and your commitment to Our Lord. It has been a challenging time ... but also a time of many graces as well. Know of my continued prayers for you all and looking forward to seeing you all this weekend. God bless us all!

**PADRE LOAIZA**  
**SIGNIFICADO DE LA ORILLA**

"Pasemos a la otra orilla" no tiene sólo un significado intrascendentemente geográfico. Es salir de las propias fronteras de la tierra creyente, allí donde se pisa suelo firme y conocido y adentrarse en territorio pagano.

Hay dos actitudes en la evangelización. Atrincerarse en la propia orilla. Defender las propias posiciones. Buscar la seguridad y la tranquilidad de lo conocido, lo propio, donde encontramos nuestras mismas creencias e ideas, donde vivimos compartiendo las mismas posiciones. O bien, creer en la Buena Noticia y llevarla más allá de nuestras fronteras. Arriesgarse a otras orillas en las cuales no encontraremos las seguridades y muchas veces sí los riesgos de situaciones, ideologías, personas que no nos son familiares.

El Reino de Dios es tan expansivo y dinámico que nunca debemos guardarlo en "nuestra orilla", que siempre debemos llevarlo hacia otras orillas y fronteras. Así confiaremos en su virtualidad y fuerza más que en nuestras propias posibilidades.

El Reino de Dios anunciado en parábolas se va a mostrar fecundo en "una y otra orilla". El discípulo de Jesús debe llevarlo siempre a nuevas orillas y fronteras, como el mismo Jesús.

El salir de la propia orilla, de la comunidad creyente, en busca de nuevos horizontes para el reino, es ante todo adentrarse en el mar. El mar es bíblicamente no sólo un dato geográfico, sino símbolo del caos, del desorden, de los poderes del mal. No es raro que sople el huracán y se levanten tempestades.

Es más, Jesús duerme. Cuando se levantan las fuerzas del mal amenazantes contra el hombre, cuando el poder del dinero amenaza con discriminar gran parte de la humanidad y condenarla al hambre, cuando el odio y la rivalidad engullen en guerras absurdas vidas humanas, cuando la manipulación de los seres humanos en la política o en la economía crean dolor y sufrimiento, parece que Dios está ausente, parece que duerme.

Casi instintivamente parecemos pensar que Dios estaba bien despierto en "nuestra orilla" y aquí en el mar duerme ausente, que quizá debimos quedarnos allí y no lanzarnos en busca de nuevas orillas y fronteras de evangelización. Que éste no es nuestro sitio. Pero aquí se nos quiere dar un doble mensaje: la Buena Noticia del reino y la comunidad cristiana deben hacerse presente allí donde hay hombres, allí donde se juega su porvenir y felicidad. Aunque sea aparentemente campo de los poderes económicos y políticos, culturales y religiosos.

Pero además, que donde esté el hombre, aunque se crea solo ante el inmenso peligro de los poderes caóticos de este mundo, allí también está Jesús el Señor. Jesús no es el Señor "de esta orilla", de los cristianos de siempre, de las misas dominicales, de los momentos devotos. Jesús es Señor también allí donde el hombre se siente amenazado, cuando no se pisa tierra firme y parece que todo va a contribuir al futuro del naufragio de la humanidad. Dios como dormido, en forma discreta de una pascal ausencia, está allí y es Señor. Ellos se dijeron espantados: "Pero, ¿quién es éste? ¡Hasta el viento y las aguas le obedecen!" ¡Es el colmo! Han aprendido la lección. No es Señor solamente en la orilla propia, en casa, en la Iglesia, en medio de mis seguridades, también está presente autoritativamente, con poder, allí donde el agua y los vientos presagian otros señoríos.
