FROM THE DESK OF FATHER PAVINO

This July is my 6th month here at St. Peter Church. When I first arrived here, one of the many questions I got from parishioners was: what are my plans for the parish? Honestly, that was a tough question to answer and frankly, I do not have any plans yet at this time. I was thinking to spend my first six months in the parish observing what kind of parish St. Peter's is, looking at the needs of the people, and considering the forte and the talents of the parishioners. And from there, I will start planning to where St. Peter Church will go.

In the 6th chapter of the Gospel according to St. John, Jesus Christ revealed to the crowd who were following Him that He is the Bread of Life, and the Bread of Life is His flesh. For this reason, people started abandoning Jesus. People cannot accept what Jesus Christ revealed to them. Jesus turned to His Disciples and asked them if they would also desert Him. It was Peter who said: "LORD, TO WHOM SHALL WE GO? YOU HAVE THE WORDS OF ETERNAL LIFE."

Clearly, Peter was speaking about salvation when he mentioned eternal life. Peter believes that Jesus is the Christ, the Messiah and that Jesus will lead them to the kingdom of God - redemption. The catechism of the Catholic Church also teaches us the same doctrine that Christ is our salvation. This was why Jesus instituted the Catholic Church - for the salvation of mankind. To simply put it, Jesus Christ established His Church to effect salvation. The purpose of the church is to realize redemption that was wrought to us by Christ. Therefore, St. Peter Church exists with the very same purpose - to bring people to heaven to eternal life, to effect salvation.

So now, may I invite you to focus on this thrust: SALUS ANIMARUM - the Salvation of Souls. Like our patron Saint Peter, let us firmly hold onto this principle. We are St. Peter Church and we are a community of believers who are faithful to Christ, believing in Him, loving Him and serving Him, until we come face to face with Him in His kingdom. Amen.

PADRE LOAIZA QUE ES LA VOCACION?

La **vocación** es la inclinación a cualquier **estado**, **Carrera** o **profesión**. El término proviene del latín *vocatio* y, para los religiosos, es la **inspiración con que Dios llama a algún estado**. Por eso el concepto también se utiliza como sinónimo de llamamiento o convocación. A nivel general, la vocación aparece relacionada con los **anhelos** y con aquello que resulta inspirador para cada sujeto. Se supone que la vocación **concuere** con los **gustos**, los **intereses** y las **aptitudes** de la persona.

La vocación se asocia a la elección de un camino.

Una construcción continua. La vocación también es considerada como un proceso que se desarrolla durante toda la vida, ya que se **construye de forma permanente**. Implica descubrir *quién soy, cómo soy hacia dónde quiero ir*. Las respuestas a esos interrogantes marcarán la vocación y el camino a seguir por el individuo.

Al finalizar la escuela secundaria, cada ser humano comienza actuar en consecuencia con su vocación. La elección de una **carrera profesional** o de un **trabajo**, por ejemplo, suele responder a la vocación. En muchos centros educativos, se valen de la ayuda de los **orientadores vocacionales**, quienes a través de una serie de tests y charlas intentan que los adolescentes sigan un camino que los satisfaga al terminar sus estudios obligatorios.

Sin embargo, el proceso de **descubrimiento** de la propia vocación es muy complejo y no es igual para todas las personas. Hay quienes creen haber sabido desde siempre que sienten un **fuerte lazo** con una determinada disciplina, y éstos contrastan con las personas que llegan a la mitad de sus vidas y se preguntan qué han hecho y por qué. La orientación vocacional suele fallar más veces de las que acierta, ya que se basa en una receta cerrada, que ignora los aspectos fundamentales de cada persona, y que pretende dar con una respuesta en el menor tiempo posible.

La música puede ser una vocación.

Por lo general, quienes suelen tener clara *su misión en este planeta* son los artistas, y eso explica que el concepto de vocación esté tan ligado al **arte**. La pregunta es, entonces, ¿por qué? ¿Por qué un cantante que se sienta en una calle peatonal con su guitarra y vive de las monedas que amablemente le donan los transeúntes se muestra más satisfecho que un contador que gana lo suficiente para mantener a su pareja y a tres hijos?

La vocación debería ser aquello que nos llena, que da a cada célula de nuestro cuerpo una sensación insuperable, una actividad que mientras la realizamos nos haga sentir que no necesitamos de nada más. Contrastando esto con el ritmo de vida que se lleva en la actualidad y con la creciente tendencia de la gente de tapar los problemas con ruido y con dinero, se entiende que muy pocos hayan oído ese **llamado** y que aún menos personas le hayan hecho caso. Algunas vocaciones son:

Administración de Empresas, Contabilidad, Ingeniería Industrial, Marketing Digital, vida consagrada, sacerdotes, vida matrimonial, llamados a vivir solteros, mecánicos, abogados, médicos, maestros, científicos, psicólogos, químicos etc. Tu has sido llamado por Dios a la vocación que estas viviendo se feliz y disfruta lo que haces.
