FROM THE DESK OF FATHER PAVINO

One thing I learned from my spiritual director is to wait, especially when one's emotion is heightened. When you are extremely happy or sad, he told me not to make any decision but to wait for a while until my emotion subsides. It is important not to just give in to our impulses. We must learn to wait. Let me share an article I read about the significance of waiting.

Choosing life instead of death demands an act of will that often contradicts our impulses. Our impulses want to take revenge, while our wills want to offer forgiveness. Our impulses push us to an immediate response: When someone hits us in the face, we impulsively want to hit back.

How then can we let our wills dominate our impulses? The key word is wait. Whatever happens, we must put some space between the hostile act directed toward us and our response. We must distance ourselves, take time to think, talk it over with friends, and wait until we are ready to respond in a life-giving way. Impulsive responses allow evil to master us, something we will always regret. But a well thought-through response will help us to "master evil with good" (Romans 12.21).

"Do not repay evil with evil, or insult with insult, but with blessing, because to this you were called so that you may inherit a blessing." - 1 Peter 3: 9

PADRE LOAIZA

DIOS HIZO AL HOMBRE Y A LA MUJER CON IGUAL DIGNIDAD

La primera lectura de este domingo nos explica la creación de la pareja humana. El autor sagrado no quiere darnos una explicación científica o histórica, sino teológica y humana, a la vez. Se trata de un relato que, detrás de la sencillez de su lenguaje que hace pensar en historietas populares, tiene una gran profundidad y nos transmite verdades profundas.

Empieza con la reflexión que se hace Dios después de haber modelado al hombre de la arcilla: "No está bien que el hombre esté solo". En efecto: la persona humana no encuentra la plenitud del sentido de su existencia en sí misma, sino en la relación con los demás. En un primer momento, el Creador proporciona al hombre aquello que hemos venido a llamar "animales de compañía". Dios crea gran cantidad de animales y los regala al hombre. Los hace desfilar ante él para que les ponga nombre, como señal de que le pertenecen. Y afirma con cierto humor el autor sagrado que el nombre que ahora damos a cada animal (como si en el universo entero sólo existiera esa lengua) es el mismo que les diera Adán en aquel desfile.

-La mujer es de la misma dignidad que el hombre. Así pues, Adán "no encontraba ninguno como él que lo ayudase". Entonces el Creador le dió a alguien que no será ya un animal de compañía, sino una compañera. ¡Cuántas bromas se han hecho a partir de la costilla de Adán! En contra de lo pretendido por algunos, el autor sagrado no quiere decir que la mujer sea inferior al hombre, sino todo lo contrario: no es un animalillo más como aquellos que no le servían para superar su soledad; sino que Adán, al ver a Eva, exclama: "¡Ésta sí que es hueso de mis huesos y carne de mi carne!". La mujer es de la misma naturaleza y dignidad que el hombre.
