The oils include the oil of the sick, used in the anointing of the sick; the oil of catechumens, which is for those preparing to be baptized, and the chrism oil, which is consecrated and used for baptism, confirmation and holy orders. **Bishop Wack will celebrate the Chrism Mass at the Cathedral of the Sacred Heart on Tuesday, April 16th at 10:00 am.**

The Triduum

The Essence of Our Faith

Holy Thursday - The Triduum is our faith in three days - the Paschal Mystery in its essence. It begins with Jesus' gift of himself in the Eucharist and includes his command that we serve other as he has served, that is, with his whole life, even in the grittiest dimensions of human life.

Good Friday - The Passion encompasses every kind of suffering - physical, psychological, shame, humiliation, mockery and more - including death. In Jesus' case, it made no sense cosmically for a totally innocent man to become a scapegoat for us and endure the unmerited suffering as an archetype for all our suffering.

Holy Saturday and Easter Vigil - At the end of the normal course of human life, that is, death, all seemed to be lost. And from a strictly human, earthly perspective it was. The resurrection came out of the blue, just as creation itself did in the first place. Unexpected, beyond our imagining, the resurrection of Jesus makes it possible for us to hope for eternal life.

The St. Rose of Lima Ladies Society is offering a \$1,000.00 college scholarship to a high school senior who is a registered member of St. Rose of Lima.

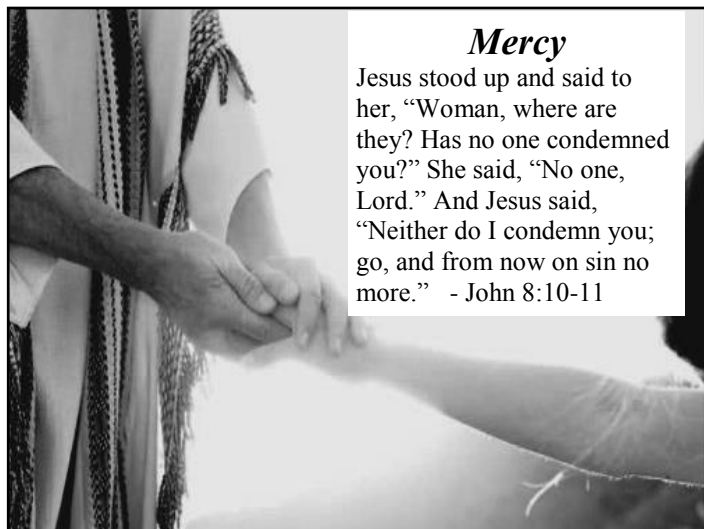

Sacrament of Marriage - Marriage preparation must begin at least six months prior to the date of the wedding. Call the parish office to make an appointment with our priests.

Anointing of the Sick - Anointing is administered to bring spiritual strength and healing during an illness, before surgery or procedures, and especially near time of death. Call the parish office to make arrangements.

Assistance for Victims of Sexual Abuse
