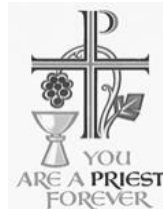


May Crowning of Mary Sunday, May 12th

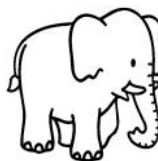

Sacrament of Baptism - Arrangements for baptism must be made in advance, and preparation is required prior to scheduling the date. Stop by the parish office to complete the baptismal application, or call Karen at 623-3600 ext. 101.

Sacrament of Reconciliation - Every Saturday from 2:00 - 3:30 pm, and first Monday of the month from 5:30 - 7:00 pm. Confessions will be heard in the chapel.

Sacrament of Marriage - Marriage preparation must begin at least six months prior to the date of the wedding. Call the parish office to make an appointment with our priests.

Anointing of the Sick - Anointing is administered to bring spiritual strength and healing during an illness, before surgery or procedures, and especially near time of death. Call the parish office to make arrangements.

Assistance for Victims of Sexual Abuse

A relationship of faith and commitment exists between the Catholic Church and its members, and the public, whether they are children, young people, adults, or elderly. Sexual abuse in this context, or any other relationship, is a matter of grave concern. Knowledge of such abuse requires a Special response in order to facilitate the healing process and assure the safety of the community. The Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee has established Victim Assistance Coordinators who are experienced, trained counselors.
