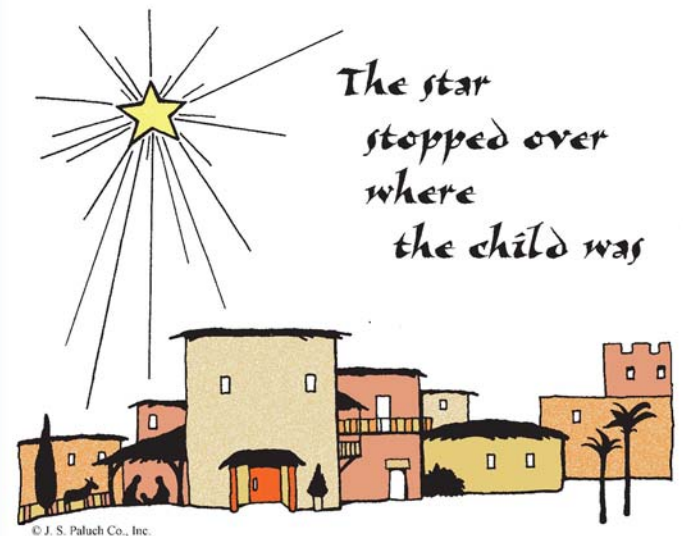

**Sacrament of Reconciliation** - Every Saturday from 2:00 - 3:30 pm, and first Monday of the month from 5:30 - 7:00 pm. Confessions will be heard in the chapel.

**Sacrament of Marriage** - Marriage preparation must begin at least six months prior to the date of the wedding. Call the parish office to make an appointment with our priests.

**Anointing of the Sick** - Anointing is administered to bring spiritual strength and healing during an illness, before surgery or procedures, and especially near time of death. Call the parish office to make arrangements.

**Assistance for Victims of Sexual Abuse**

A relationship of faith and commitment exists between the Catholic Church and its members, and the public, whether they are children, young people, adults, or elderly. Knowledge of such abuse requires a Special response in order to facilitate the healing process and assure the safety of the community.
