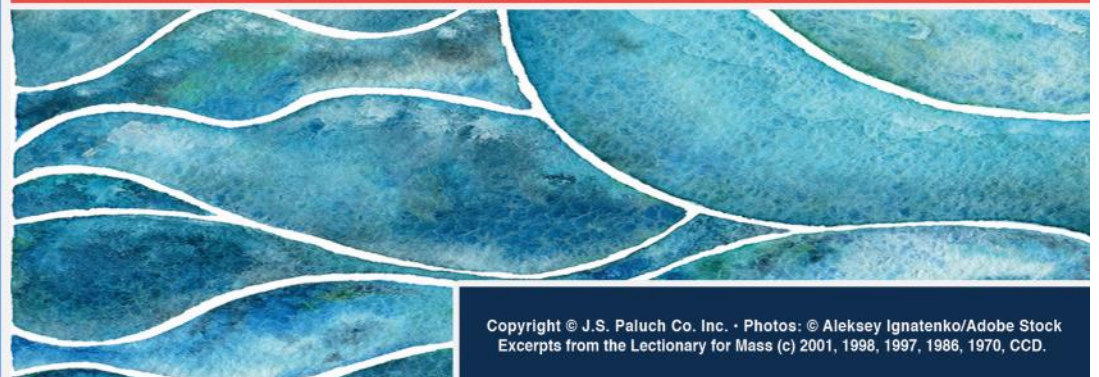

Year Round Stewardship

Electronic Giving is a convenient, consistent way to help our church year round.

Consider scheduling a recurring electronic contribution today. It's easy! You will no longer need to write out checks and prepare envelopes every week. Even when travel, illness or other circumstances prevent you from attending services, your electronic contributions will continue to be received on an uninterrupted basis. You are even given options for where it goes (ie. Offertory, CSA, Building fund, food pantry/Outreach, etc).

Direct Debit Giving is used to automatically transfer funds from your bank checking or savings account to the church's bank account. There is no fees charged to the Parish for this.

Simply click on the GIVE NOW button on the main screen and follow the onscreen instructions to create and online profile and schedule your recurring contributions.

Quick Response (QR) can be used from your smartphone. Download a QR reader app, then take a picture of the code below and it will take you directly to online giving.



Did you know that you can also give by text?

It's called GIVE+, and you can quickly and conveniently give securely by texting our secure 10 digit Give+ number that is specifically linked to **our** Vanco online account!

1. Text to 850-367-7687 and the amount you wish to donate, then press send.
2. You will receive a registration link. Click the link and enter your contact and payment information. Tap "Process".
3. After registration is complete, you will receive a verification text as well as a receipt via email.
4. For future giving, simply send a text with the amount you wish to give, and it will process automatically. Safe and secure!

Sacrament of Baptism - Arrangements for baptism must be made in advance, and preparation is required prior to scheduling the date. Stop by the parish office to complete the baptismal application, or call Karen at 623-3600 ext. 101.

Sacrament of Reconciliation - Every Saturday from 2:00 - 3:30 pm, and first Monday of the month from 5:30 - 7:00 pm. Confessions will be heard in the chapel.

Sacrament of Marriage - Marriage preparation must begin at least six months prior to the date of the wedding. Call the parish office to make an appointment with our priests.

Anointing of the Sick - Anointing is administered to bring spiritual strength and healing during an illness, before surgery or procedures, and especially near time of death. Call the parish office to make arrangements.

Assistance for Victims of Sexual Abuse

A relationship of faith and commitment exists between the Catholic Church and its members, and the public, whether they are children, young people, adults, or elderly. Sexual abuse in this context, or any other relationship, is a matter of grave concern. Knowledge of such abuse requires a Special response in order to facilitate the healing process and assure the safety of the community.
