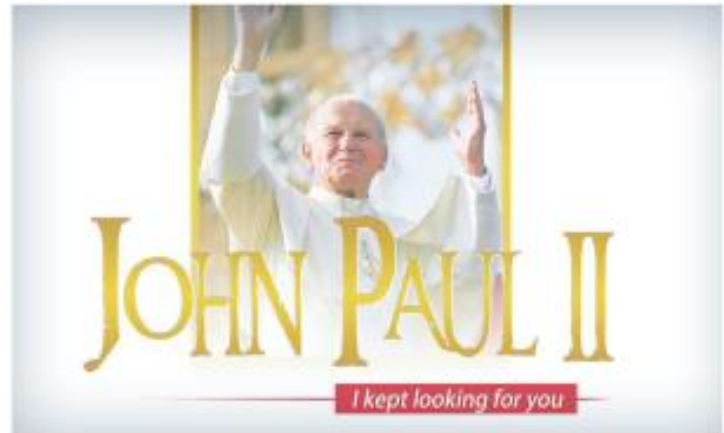

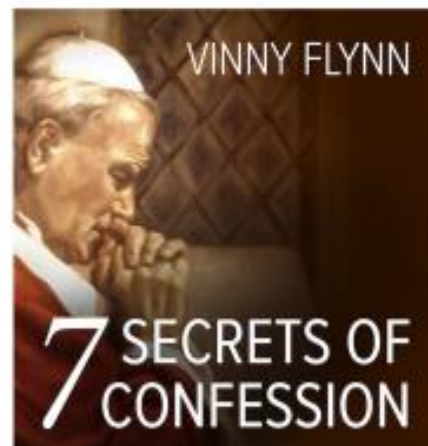

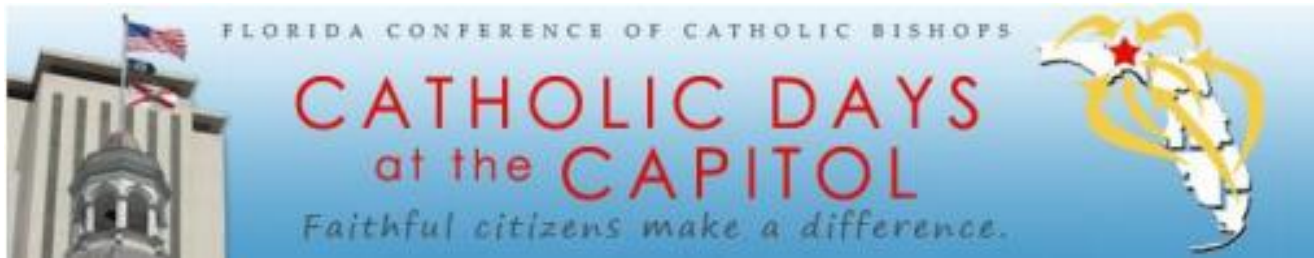

February 2, 2021 at 2:00 pm through February 3, 2021

To ensure the health and safety of participants in light of the coronavirus, the 2021 Catholic Days at the Capitol will be a virtual event. Previous attendees as well as those who have not been able to join Catholics in Tallahassee for this annual event are urged to take this opportunity to participate virtually this coming year. During these unprecedented times, through innovation and technology, Catholics can continue to bring their values and voices to political life to promote and protect human life and dignity.

Online activities will begin the afternoon of Tuesday, February 2nd with a welcome and legislative briefing on public policy priorities. Virtual activities will continue on Wednesday, February 3rd, including a rosary with the bishops of Florida and a Defensor Vitae award presentation to a legislator. These online activities will be recorded and available to view by registered participants later in the day or evening if desired. Virtual group meetings with legislators will be scheduled for participants to attend.

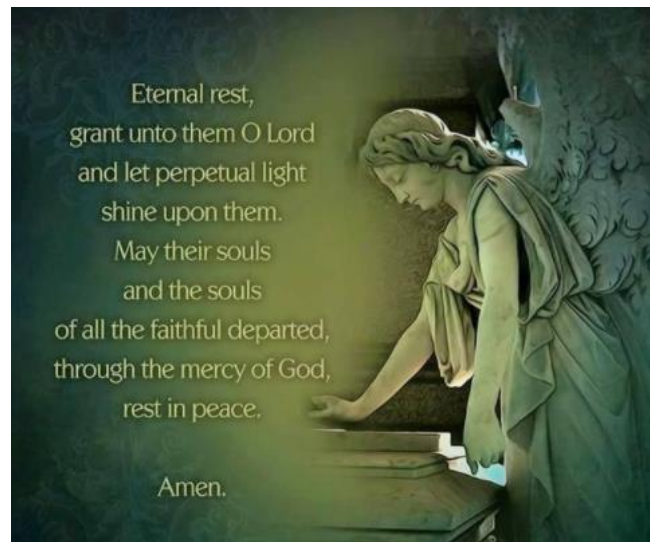

Sacraments

Baptism - Arrangements for baptism must be made in advance, and preparation is required prior to scheduling the date. Call Karen at 623-3600 ext. 101.

Confession - Confession is held in the Chapel every Saturday from 1:30 pm to 3:00 pm, or by appointment by calling 850-623-3600.

First Monday Confession - First Monday of each month from 5:30 pm to 7 pm in the Chapel.

Sacrament of Marriage - Marriage preparation must begin at least six months prior to the date of the wedding. Call the office to make an appointment with one of our priests.

Anointing of the Sick - Anointing is administered to bring spiritual strength and healing during an illness, before surgery or procedures, and especially near time of death. Call the parish office to make arrangements.

Assistance for Victims of Sexual Abuse

If you are a victim of abuse, or you suspect a child or a vulnerable adult is being abused by anyone, call the Florida Abuse Hotline at 1-800-96-ABUSE (1-800-962-2873). To report abuse within the Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee involving a priest, deacon or other church personnel, you may also call the Diocesan Abuse Reporting Hotline at 850-435-3536 or report via email to: bishopsoffice@ptdiocese.org. Please include your first and last name, your contact information and how you would prefer to be contacted. The Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee encourages anyone aware of abuse by a priest, deacon or church personnel **to make a report immediately**. Your report enables us to better ensure the safety of all and to help individuals in the healing process. All information supplied is maintained in strictest confidence, except where disclosure is required by law. According to Florida law, all are considered "mandatory reporters" of abuse and must report the abuse of a child or a vulnerable adult.
