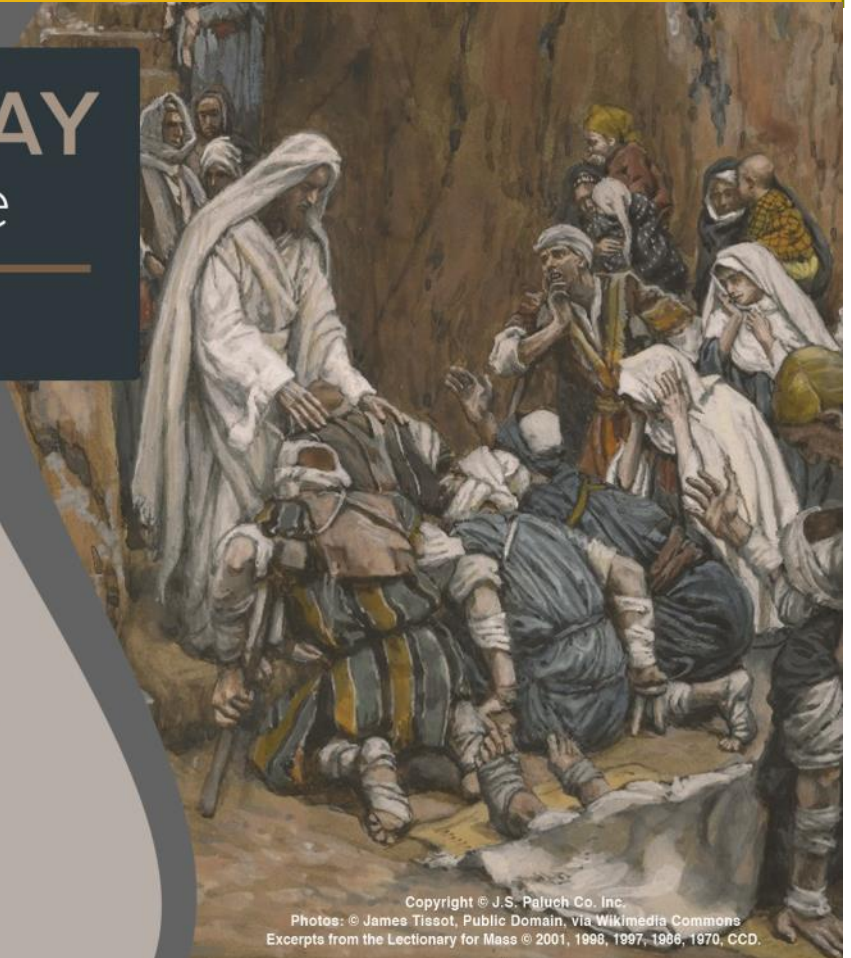

Rosary Workshop

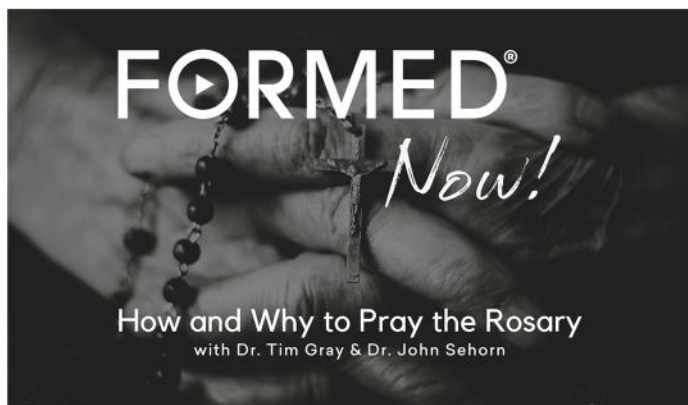

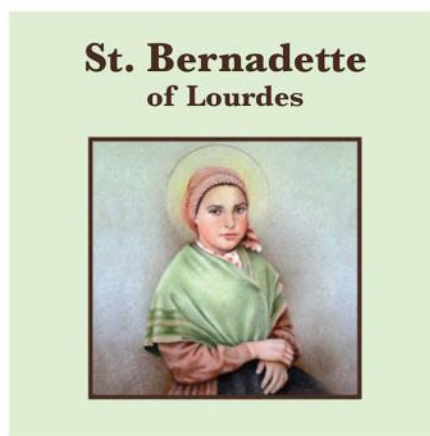

Reflection



The fact that today's Gospel from Mark makes reference to Jesus curing Peter's mother-in-law would seem to point to the fact that Peter was married. However, the majority of scholars are of the opinion that the wife may have died before Peter was called by Jesus as an Apostle. In fact, there are many misconceptions about St. Peter. For one, although often portrayed as much older, he was probably younger than Jesus. In fact, all twelve Apostles were most likely younger than Jesus.

Also, Peter is often presented in paintings and movies and books as being a very old man, but historians have also concluded that Peter was martyred in Rome when he was about 66 years old. He was never the old, old man we see quite often.

All of that is secondary to a simple statement in today's Gospel about the mother-in-law. Specifically, St. Mark writes, "He (Jesus) approached, grasped her hand, and helped her up. Then the fever left her and she waited on them." St. Matthew reveals this same fact in his Gospel (Matthew 8:15), and he writes, "He (Jesus) touched her hand and the fever left her, and she got up and began to serve him."

The message for us is very basic. Peter's mother-in-law responded to Jesus the same way we should when Jesus blesses us. She responded to the Lord and immediately served Him out of gratitude. That should be our motivation, and action, as well.

Sacraments

Baptism - Arrangements for baptism must be made in advance, and preparation is required prior to scheduling the date. Call Karen at 623-3600 ext. 101.

Confession - Confession is held in the Chapel every Saturday from 1:30 pm to 3:00 pm, or by appointment by calling 850-623-3600.

First Monday Confession - First Monday of each month from 5:30 pm to 7 pm in the Chapel.

Sacrament of Marriage - Marriage preparation must begin at least six months prior to the date of the wedding. Call the office to make an appointment with one of our priests.

Anointing of the Sick - Anointing is administered to bring spiritual strength and healing during an illness, before surgery or procedures, and especially near time of death. Call the parish office to make arrangements.

Assistance for Victims of Sexual Abuse

If you are a victim of abuse, or you suspect a child or a vulnerable adult is being abused by anyone, call the Florida Abuse Hotline at 1-800-96-ABUSE (1-800-962-2873). To report abuse within the Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee involving a priest, deacon or other church personnel, you may also call the Diocesan Abuse Reporting Hotline at 850-435-3536 or report via email to: bishopsoffice@ptdiocese.org. Please include your first and last name, your contact information and how you would prefer to be contacted. The Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee encourages anyone aware of abuse by a priest, deacon or church personnel **to make a report immediately**. Your report enables us to better ensure the safety of all and to help individuals in the healing process. All information supplied is maintained in strictest confidence, except where disclosure is required by law. According to Florida law, all are considered "mandatory reporters" of abuse and must report the abuse of a child or a vulnerable adult.
