On April 24, at their convention, the Diocesan Council of Catholic Women presented the Burse check to Bishop Wack. This collection is taken up in each parish of the diocese all year and the total is presented to the Bishop at our convention. This committee was founded and is directed by the women of the council. We are very pleased to announce the total for this year is \$311,041.74. This surpasses all other efforts. In 1981 we presented a check of \$31,000.00 and through the effort of many people it has steadily grown. ***This year I am pleased to announce that St. Rose of Lima parish contributed \$11,557.87 to the total amount!*** We were the fourth highest contributor in the diocese!

Congratulations to all of Molly Leonard's many volunteers and to those who contribute at St. Rose. Did you know that it costs over \$60,000.00 a year to educate one seminarian? All Burse funds go to registration & books, and this helps to offset the steep costs to the seminarians. 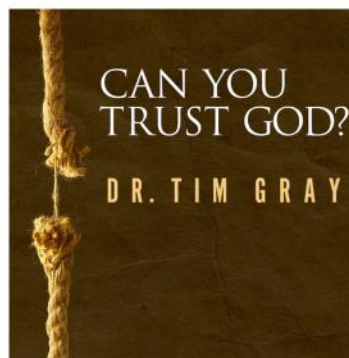

Baptism - Arrangements for baptism must be made in advance, and preparation is required prior to scheduling the date. Call Karen at 623-3600 ext. 101.

Confession - Confession is held in the Chapel every Saturday from 1:30 pm to 3:00 pm, or by appointment by calling 850-623-3600.

First Monday Confession - First Monday of each month from 5:30 pm to 7 pm in the Chapel.

Sacrament of Marriage - Marriage preparation must begin at least six months prior to the date of the wedding. Call the office to make an appointment with one of our priests.

Anointing of the Sick - Anointing is administered to bring spiritual strength and healing during an illness, before surgery or procedures, and especially near time of death. Call the parish office to make arrangements.
