

St. Rose of Lima Pastoral Council – Monthly Meeting Minutes
April 29, 2014
7PM CDT

Council members in attendance: Msgr. Michael Reed, Deacon Chris Christopher, Bill Gibson, Steve Rhodes, Vic Vangrowski, Chris Gay, Molly Leonard, Noelle Bradberry, Joe Courey, Kate Lewis.

Msgr. Reed opened the meeting in prayer.

Minutes:

- Noelle Bradberry asked for questions, concerns, and/or if there were any changes to be made to the March meeting minutes. Bill Gibson motioned to approve the March meeting minutes as presented. Steve Rhodes seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Old Business:

- Msgr. Reed discussed the Building Committee's decision to move forward with the completion of the second floor of the new building for a total of \$160,000. Once the new building is completed, construction on the administrative offices will begin. In an e-mail from Rob Bennett, Director of Construction and Properties with the Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee, it was stated that after review of the financial information and condition of St. Rose of Lima Parish, the Diocese is prepared to approve a loan of no more than \$200,000 for the construction of the new buildings for a period of 5 years. Joe Courey motioned to move forward with the completion of the new building. Kate Lewis seconded the motion. The motion carried. The Pastoral Council will notify parishioners of this decision.
- Playground construction will be placed on hold until the completion on the new building.
- Joe Courey suggested placing the temporary sign in the dirt parking lot across the street. Everyone in attendance agreed. Joe Courey and Vic Vangrowski will work on moving the sign to its new location.
- Steve Rhodes explained that the ceiling within the church is suspended and not designed to support body weight which leaves very few access points for maintenance. He will provide estimates for installing sheetrock/foam in an effort to reduce mold development. Additionally, Steve will look to obtain price quotes and reasonable options to secure and fence in the air conditioning units.
- Msgr. Reed stated that Dennis Flores will survey the parking lot to determine problem areas in need of maintenance. Vic Vangrowski suggested that the ushers begin to assist those who have difficulties walking into the church by standing outside before and after each Mass. Joe Courey agreed to follow up with the ushers and will also contact Dennis to discuss resurfacing the parking lot.
- Steve Rhodes stated that John Canning has moved forward with the development of the new website through the eCatholic server. He will talk to John to discuss who will have administrative rights to the new website in order for edits and updates to be made, which John and Karen Bradberry, parish secretary, have been reviewing. Kate Lewis will

review the current website to collect information on what is still current, and will discuss this information with Karen who is aware of the discrepancies.

- Bill Gibson will make sure the current ministry list is updated on the website and will e-mail the template for ministry reports to the Council.

New Business:

- As a Board member of the Florida SIDS Alliance, Lea O'Neill announced that she is trained and certified to counsel those who have lost children and has offered to be a contact for the Bereavement Committee as needed or requested.

Msgr. Reed closed the meeting in prayer.
