Dear Families,

Welcome back to our Family Faith Formation on Sunday mornings from 9:15 – 10:15 am at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church! To assure the health and safety of everyone, the following procedures have been put into place by our pastor and/or our diocese at this time:

1. The wearing of face masks is **required** by everyone during our Family Faith Formation in the Education Building and Parish Hall. Please wear your own clean face masks if possible. Disposable face masks will be available in each classroom.
2. Please take the temperature of your family members before coming to Family Faith Formation to make sure that everyone is healthy. Please do not bring anyone to Family Faith Formation that has the chills, fever, sore throat, stomach pain, head ache, body aches, cough, nasal congestion, diarrhea, vomiting, difficulty breathing, etc.
3. Touchless hand sanitizers will be available at the end of each hallway in the Education Building for your use. Hand sanitizers will also be available in each classroom
4. Classroom supplies will be stored in individual gallon sized plastic bags labeled with your child's name for use.
5. Frequently touched surfaces in the Education Building will be disinfected before and after each class session on Sunday mornings.
6. Hand washing will be required after the use of a bathroom.
7. Each student will sit at his or her own table, chair or on a carpeted floor 6 feet away from others in each classroom.
8. Families who are able to walk up the stairs, are asked to enter the Education Building from the East entrance by the elevator and to leave the building through the West Exit door and stairwell.
9. Please maintain social distancing between families in the hallways and stairwells of the Education Building.
10. Parents will NOT enter the classroom for drop off or pick up. At dismissal, the children will remain seated until called by the Catechist or classroom assistant to leave with their parent.
11. All food and beverages that are brought to be shared must be purchased from a store and individually packaged.
12. Water will NOT be available in the hallways. Parents are encouraged to send a filled water bottle with their child if necessary. Mini disposable water bottles will be available in each classroom.
