Dear Family,

It's both graduation and ordination season. This coming week will be the last week for our schools. Please pray for a fruitful week and a blessed, restorative, and joyful summer. Congrats again to all of our graduates. Ordinations are happening in dioceses all across the U.S. from now through the end of June. I will be hitting the road for different ordinations (Houma and Lafayette) of men who were at LSU the year that I spent at CTK 7 years ago. Also, this coming Saturday, May 28th, Bishop Muench will ordain Dc. Eddie Martin to the priesthood and seminarian Ryan Hallford to the diaconate. One must be first ordained a deacon before he can be ordained a priest. Next summer Ryan will be ordained a priest. Please keep our seminarians in prayer. As I write this I am headed to Baton Rouge to participate in five final Vocation Board interviews with some of the candidates applying for seminary this Fall. We currently have 3-4 more men applying as well. Please pray for the gift of Counsel and Wisdom that we will make the decisions God desires!

Beginning this Monday we will have seven days of prayer asking God to break down any walls that we may have individual or communally in our hearts which block His graces from flowing deeply. Why seven days? We are taking our inspiration from the sixth chapter of the Book of Joshua in the Old Testament. God asked the Israelites to carry the Ark of the Covenant around the walls of the city of Jericho for 7 days. In their prayerful obedience to the Lord's request He tore down the walls and allowed the Israelites to claim victory and claim the Promised Land. We are going to gather at 6:30pm Monday - Saturday to pray in faith trusting the Lord will move. Monday through Wednesday we will gather at St. Jules. Thursday through Saturday we will gather at St. Elizabeth. On the last day we will have a Eucharistic Procession after the 10:45 Mass at St. Elizabeth. Please come out any night that you can for prayer and certainly for the Procession. We will follow the Lord in His Presence in the Holy Eucharist acknowledging that we need to follow Him in all things. When we follow His lead, He breaks down any walls that may be keeping us from experiencing the fullness of His life that He so desires to give us. Our prayers will be for ourselves, our families, communities, and the entire world. A simple, humble act of faith in God opens up an ocean of grace. Join us in this wonderful venture on Corpus Christi Sunday – the Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

THE MOST HOLY TRINITY - MAY 22, 2016

JOSHUA 6:12-16; 20

Early the next morning, Joshua had the priests take up the ark of the LORD. The seven priests bearing the ram's horns marched in front of the ark of the LORD, blowing their horns. Ahead of these marched the picked troops, while the rear guard followed the ark of the LORD, and the blowing of horns was kept up continually. On this second day they again marched around the city once before returning to camp; and for six days in all they did the same.

On the seventh day, beginning at daybreak, they marched around the city seven times in the same manner; on that day only did they march around the city seven times. The seventh time around, the priests blew the horns and Joshua said to the people, "Now shout, for the LORD has given you the city..."
