Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

They even had a small prayer carpet to use for prayer. It was a unique scene to observe with a Muslim, a Christian, and two Catholic priest praying all in one spot.

So why am I mentioning this? We all need to live out our faith each and every day which includes when we travel. If you are flying, see if the airport has a chapel or quiet place to pray. I certainly valued it, and I am sure you would as well. If you are traveling by car, how about beginning your travels with a prayer and offer a prayer when you arrive to your destination? 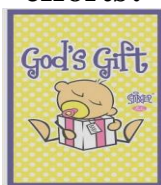
