My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

A happy and blessed Easter season to all of you! I wanted to thank everyone who made the Triduum as well as Easter Sunday so beautiful. A big thank you to the members of the choir who helped to provide music that set the mood and tone for each of the liturgies for the Triduum. Thanks to all who volunteered as altar servers, lectors, extraordinary ministers of holy communion, and ushers! A big thank you to Wheeler Oschwald who served as the Master of Ceremonies at the Triduum which truly helped me to focus more on the liturgies. Finally, thanks to those who helped to decorate and take care of our Churches as well. Both of our churches have been beautifully decorated for Easter Sunday. If you are interested in helping out with any of the ministries throughout the year, please call me at the office or send me an email. We are always looking for people to get involved and help out.

While I know many this weekend are focusing on Allons Manger this Sunday, which is a wonderful celebration for our community, it is also Divine Mercy Sunday this weekend. As you might know, this devotion was promoted by Pope St. John Paul II. It is a beautiful devotion that helps to focus ourselves ultimately on what the Resurrection of Jesus Christ centers on, mercy! He came to redeem us and renew us to what God the Father had originally intended for us. One author describes God's mercy "to relieve us of a heart that is in misery." Misery because of sin and brokenness. How do we encounter this mercy? Thomas the Apostle is a great example. He doubted but also still searched and interacted with the Lord; he examined and touched the wounds of the Lord. We are called to do the same in daily reflections and spiritual life. We also encounter this in the Sacrament of Reconciliation and the Sacrament of the Eucharist! These sacraments flow from his wounds! I encourage you to reflect on this just as you did on Good Friday!

Switching to the calendar this coming week. A reminder that there will be no Confession, Adoration, or Mass on Monday evening as we will be celebrating the Sacrament of Confirmation with Bishop Duca at 7:00 pm at St. Elizabeth Church. Everyone is invited to attend. I suggest arriving early to get a seat. Next Saturday, I will offer a 1st Saturday Mass at 8:00 am at St. Jules Church for anyone who is interested. Also, later that day, we will be celebrating with those who will be receiving their 1st Communion at the 4:00 pm. So, please keep in your prayers those receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation as well as the Sacrament of the Eucharist for the first time.
