Third Sunday of Easter

They serve as a beautiful reminder for all of us to recognize how special of a moment it is for each of us as we go to Communion and receive such a precious gift the Lord has given to us that unites us, heals us, and strengthens us in our journey.

Speaking of this precious gift the Lord has given to us, this weekend we will be having the distribution of the Precious Blood. It is my plan to have both species of the Eucharist available on the 1st weekend of the month. Many parishioners have asked when we would be able to have the Precious Blood offered again. I feel this is the right time and the perfect liturgical season to begin again. One important thing for us to keep in mind is to be aware of "who" not just "what" we are receiving. It is a sign of reverence to offer a slight bow before you receive the sacrament. When receiving the Precious Blood, please use both hands to drink from the chalice. Also, if you notice a consecrated host or a drop of the Precious Blood on the ground, please notify a minister or me immediately.
