Pentecost Sunday

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

This weekend brings the end of the Easter Season with the celebration of the Feast of Pentecost. We have reflected on a lot from the great victory over sin and death by our Lord, to his infinite love and mercy for each one of us, to a wonderful reminder of the Good Shepherd we need to follow, to what our view of heaven should be, and that we should not be afraid for the Lord to come now into our lives. This seems like a lot to remember and to always be aware of in our everyday lives and the daily routine that we go through. Pentecost is a great reminder then of the gift that you and I have received to remind us of these things and more: The Holy Spirit!

By virtue of baptism, and for most of us Confirmation, we have received this precious and free gift that brings the divine life directly to us and unites us with the Trinity. Pentecost reminds us of the gift of the Holy Spirit descending upon the apostles to carry out the mission he gave them. The same Holy Spirit is given to each one of us to be used to carry that same mission of the apostles in our particular vocation. For me, it is the person of the Trinity that, for the longest time, I neglected but most needed as I dealt with situations and discerning my own vocation. I have come to learn how much the Holy Spirit has guided me whether in the Sacraments or even everyday situations in life. I invite you to reflect and look at your own relationship with the Holy Spirit in your everyday prayer life. One of the great prayers to remind us of this is the Come Holy Spirit Prayer. It is a wonderful prayer for guidance and renewal. I encourage you to add this a prayer to what you say every day or even once a week.

Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of Thy faithful and enkindle in them the fire of Thy love.

Send forth Thy Spirit and they shall be created. And Thou shalt renew the face of the earth.

Let us pray. O God, who didst instruct the hearts of the faithful by the light of the Holy Spirit, grant us in the same Spirit to be truly wise, and ever to rejoice in His consolation.

Through Christ, our Lord. Amen.

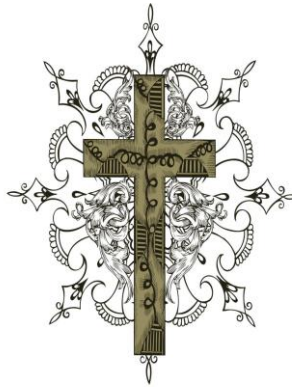

At some point in life, everyone experiences a loss. The loss can trigger a reaction that is sometimes overwhelming as one struggles to cope with that reality. The reaction to loss is labeled “grief” and is the price we pay for having loved. Because the experience of grief can be so disturbing, it is helpful to understand what is involved in this process and how we might cope with it.

This workshop will describe the normal reactions involved in grieving, outline the various “tasks” that need to be accomplished in the grieving process and suggest some basic activities to care for oneself. The workshop will also focus on grief from a faith perspective to remind us that God can bring new life even out of death as He did in the Resurrection of Jesus.
