*The Most Holy Trinity*

My dear friends of St. Jules and St. Elizabeth,

For those of you who don't know me, I am Ehren Oswald, but most people know me as Wheeler. I was born and raised in Donaldsonville and attended Ascension Catholic High School. This is where I met my wife, Annette, and moved down the bayou to Belle Rose where we have lived here for 40 years. We have two grown children, a son and a daughter, a son-in-law and two grandsons. I am a Construction Manager for River Parish Contractors and hope to be retired in the very near future! About five years ago, I felt God calling me to serve Him in a different way and after much prayer and discernment; I applied to enter into the diaconate program. So here I am today in my final year of the program.

I would like to give you an update on my progress in the diaconate formation process but first and foremost, let me say thank you for all the prayers and encouragement that I have received from you because this has definitely helped me to persevere in my formation. For those of you that have not heard the news, the formation board has assigned me to St. Jules and St. Elizabeth parish for my internship under the direction of Fr. Matthew Graham for the next year. This will be my fifth and final year of formation and if the Lord wills, I will be ordained a deacon on June 20, 2020 for the Diocese of Baton Rouge. Your prayers are more powerful than you may know and the reason I say this is because it is very rare that a candidate is placed in his home parish. Annette and I are so excited that we will be serving in our home community for the next year. One of the things I would like to share with you about the formation process is the curriculum I studied over the past four years. Formation begins with one year of discernment; we began with around 30 candidates and of those 12 were accepted into the diaconate program. The courses are taught at Franciscan University in Baton Rouge. We have covered Introduction to Theology, the Old Testament, the New Testament, Christian spirituality, Church History, Theology of the Church, Philosophy, Christian Sacraments,

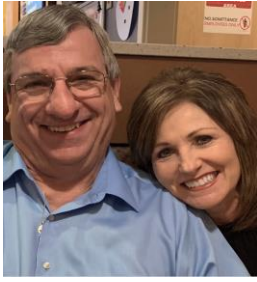

At some point in life, everyone experiences a loss. The loss can trigger a reaction that is sometimes overwhelming as one struggles to cope with that reality. The reaction to loss is labeled "grief" and is the price we pay for having loved. Because the experience of grief can be so disturbing, it is helpful to understand what is involved in this process and how we might cope with it.

This workshop will describe the normal reactions involved in grieving, outline the various "tasks" that need to be accomplished in the grieving process and suggest some basic activities to care for oneself. The workshop will also focus on grief from a faith perspective to remind us that God can bring new life even out of death as He did in the Resurrection of Jesus.
