*Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time*

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Recently, in the news, it has been reported that Pope Francis is changing the words of the Our Father prayer. I have been asked by several people about this recently. I have not looked into it too much because if it was going to truly happen, we would have been notified by the Diocese, and it would definitely be a topic amongst the priests. Here is an explanation that was sent to all priests of the Diocese that I hope will clear up some of the confusion and provide some context of what is happening.

“On June 6, the secular media reported that Pope Francis 'changed' the text of the Lord's Prayer from 'lead us not into temptation' to 'Do not let us fall into temptation.'" Pope Francis rightfully stated that God never leads us into temptation.

“Not surprisingly, the question has been asked when the 'new translation of the Lord's prayer should be implemented.' As many of you know, a new translation of the typical text will not be announced to the secular media. What happened? Many of the news outlets reported on a translation in Europe and erroneously extended it to the United States.

In 2010, the USCCB voted to keep the traditional translation of the Lord's Prayer in the English translation of the *Roman Missal, third edition*. They even retained 'thy' and 'thou' because the words were most familiar to the faithful. Until you hear otherwise, this remains the official translation for the diocese of the United States. Their owner plans at this time to revisit that translation.”

I hope this helps with what has been reported and provides some clarity. I am curious how other languages translate this same phrase. Maybe those who speak French can let me know.
