### *Twenty-First Sunday of Ordinary Time*

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

My bulletin article this week is focusing on things going on in the parish now. It is a busy time for many, however, I hope this keeps you informed of things coming up. First off, the new minister schedule for lectors, eucharistic ministers, altar servers, and sacristans will be out soon if not this weekend. Please review and let the office know if there needs to be any changes made for the future. We will also be sending out an updated contact list to help in looking for a substitute for a particular weekend. If you cannot find anyone, please let either myself or the office know as soon as possible.

We are also beginning a recruiting campaign for anyone interested in being an altar server. The person should at least be in 3rd grade and have received their first communion. Please note that I have not set an age limit. If there are any adults interested in being trained to be an altar server to help with daily Masses or even weekend Masses, please sign up as well. There is a sign-up form in the back of the Church as well as on our website. I will have a training on Saturday, September 21st at 9:00am in St. Elizabeth for all new servers as well those servers who would like a refresher.

Last weekend, I mentioned about a new program being offered in our parish called GriefShare. This is a wonderful program to help anyone who might be experiencing grief as part of a death or change in life situation and needs a path to process and work through it. The program is in a seminar format and is open to anyone in our area, not just parishioners. There will be sessions in the morning and evening. You can find more information in the bulletin as well as on our website.

For this coming week, we are placing the September issue of *The Word Among Us* in the back of each church. This is a great resource for anyone looking to have some daily scripture reading or to follow the daily Mass readings along with a daily reflection based on one of the readings. Finally, there will be **no Mass** on Monday evening, August 26th, and Tuesday morning, August 27th, as I have some appointments that I need to be at in Baton Rouge.

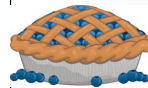
