## The Second Sunday of Lent

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

As we continue our Lenten journey there are few things I would like to highlight that are coming up:

1. Saturday, March 14th, a presentation on Alzheimer's and Caregivers will be held at the St. Elizabeth Community Center. Please see page 3 of the bulletin for more information.
2. Lenten Music Concert this Sunday, March 15th at 4:00pm. The music will be all a cappella with music from Palestrina, Schein, John Brown and Robert Ramsay. Some of the music will be Crux Fidelis, Stabat Mater, Agnus Dei by Brahms, and When David Heard. The concert is FREE! Donations will be accepted!
3. A reminder that we will have the Way of the Cross on Fridays at St. Elizabeth after the 8:00am Mass and again at 6:00pm.
4. This weekend is Safe Haven Sunday, which is promoting a campaign by our Diocese to address the major issue of pornography that is affecting our society.
