The Fourth Sunday of Lent

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

I know this is a tough period of adjustment for everyone as we all go through this unprecedented time. As for public Masses being canceled, this was very difficult for me to announce on Monday evening, and I know it is affecting everyone. However, in the history of the Church, this is not unprecedented (i.e. Spanish Flu of 1918). Even though public Masses are canceled, please know that Mass is still being celebrated every day by me and my brother priests. One inquiry I have received is about Mass intentions many of you have requested that are occurring this weekend and into the future. Will they still be remembered and offered? Not to worry, I have you covered.

By Canon Law (Canon 534), I have to offer one Mass each Sunday Pro Populo, which is Latin for the people. This means every weekend at least one Mass is dedicated to praying for all of you. Now, what about the other two Masses that I celebrate on the weekend with the listed intentions as seen in the bulletin? I will be transferring all of those intentions to the Mass I celebrate on Mondays. I will continue to do this until we can celebrate public Masses once again. As of now, I do not plan to film a live Mass since so many are already doing this. I will work on listing those on our church website. However, I will be posting daily homilies and/or reflections on a YouTube channel for everyone. You will receive all notifications I send out as well find a way to subscribe to the YouTube channel. Finally, let us continue to unite ourselves in prayer daily. Please keep in mind our Governor and elected officials! Let us pray for them daily as they seek to protect us and give us the vital information we need. Also we pray that the people of Louisiana will listen to them and follow their directions. Let us pray, as well, for those suffering from this virus whether it be physically, emotionally, psychologically, and financially. These are just a few people to keep in mind.
