Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

One of the things I cherish most about being a priest is being able to celebrate the holy sacrifice of the Mass each and every day. I remember the first Mass where I was the main celebrant. My main focus was just making sure I did everything correctly. Now, it is a true moment of peace where I can bring everything and I know that Jesus has given everything for me and for you. The challenge though is how many of us truly believe this. How many truly believe that the Eucharist is the true presence of the Lord? According to a Pew Research Poll conducted last year, over 70% of Catholics do not believe that the Eucharist the body and blood of our Lord. As a priest this causes me a lot of pain to accept but also I realize where we as priests and thus as parishes have failed to truly educate the hearts and minds of our parishes. If this has been the case for you, then I sincerely apologize. I hope this weekend we can either start again and/or grow in our appreciation of this central point of our faith.

Why do I have this hope? Starting this weekend we will have 1st communion for our 2nd graders. At all of the Masses this weekend, some during the week, and a Mass next weekend, they will be receiving the Body and Blood of our Lord for the first time. While they might not fully understand all about the Eucharist or like the taste of the host, they accept it. So they serve as example for us to come before this sacrament and mystery with wonder and excitement. We in turn need to model for them the reverence and the devotion towards it. In truth, just as much as they need us we also need them when believing and approaching this sacrament. Please say a prayer for them this weekend when you have a moment.



A program for low-income clients who have difficulty with the cost of prescription mediations. Senior RX can help people:


- Who are 60 and older or who are 21 and over and have an adult onset disability
