Praying Before, During and After Mass

Interior disposition manifests itself in exterior action. A strong temptation for us as Catholics is to simply go through the motions during Mass, to treat the Mass as just another routine activity. But the reality is that the Mass is the greatest prayer that we can participate in, and our participation is not rooted in the external things we do during Mass but in our intentional, interior disposition.

Before Mass: spend time asking the Lord to prepare your heart to receive His Word and Body in the Mass, to have that interior disposition. Recommendation: Prayer of Thomas Aquinas before Mass

During Mass: "Live the Holy Mass" - a series of visions from Jesus and Mary to a woman named Catalina detailing the reality of the Mass and how we are called to participate in the Mass. You can find a pdf of it by googling "Live the Holy Mass"

Padre Pio's prayer after receiving communion: "Stay with me Lord. As poor as my soul is, I want it to be a place of consolation for you, a nest of love."

After Mass: spend time with the Lord and not rush out. Make an act of thanksgiving for the Mass and ask the Lord to manifest the graces of the Mass into our lives.
