Dear Friends,

Thank you for all your best wishes this past weekend. Thanks for making me feel at home. You are a wonderful faith-filled community, and I feel blessed to be a part of your lives.

Communion to the Homebound by MEMBERS OF THE FAMILY ONLY – Phase I

It has been more than five months since we have been able to bring Communion to our homebound due to COVID-19 restrictions. For Phase II of the Diocesan Reopening, Bishop Michael Duca has suggested that priests allow family members to bring Communion to their family members who are unable to attend Mass. To that end, I would like to call upon the immediate family members of St. Elizabeth - St. Jules Parishes to bring Communion to your elderly relatives. Please follow the directions below:

1. You should be an immediate relative of the person to whom you are bringing Communion.
2. The person to whom you are bringing Communion should be a member of St. Elizabeth - St. Jules Parish.
3. If you are a Parishioner of St. Elizabeth - St. Jules and want to bring Communion to your relative outside the boundaries of the parish, or to a relative who is not a member of St. Elizabeth - St. Jules, you will need to obtain written permission from the Pastor of the parish where your relative resides. I do not have any jurisdiction in other parish boundaries.
4. If you are not a member of St. Elizabeth - St. Jules Parish, but would like to bring Communion to an elderly relative, please call me at 225-473-8569, Extension 6.
5. If you are not an Extra Ordinary Minister of Holy Communion (Eucharistic Minister), you will be commissioned as a Eucharistic Minister for the purpose of bringing Communion to your relative.
6. **Those of you who would like to bring Communion MUST register with the parish office before September 2, 2020. Please send an email to Linda Aucoin at office@sesjchurch.com OR call her at 985-513-2202.**

7. Brief Training, September 5-6 Weekend: Anyone who wants to bring Communion to a relative, *even if you are already an EMHC*, is required to come to church 45 minutes before the Mass on the weekend of September 5/6 for a brief training. This is mandatory.
8. Currently, we will give out Communion to the homebound only beginning on the weekend Masses of September 5/6.
9. It is the duty of the children and grandchildren (18 and above) to help your elderly parents and relatives by bringing Jesus in Holy Communion to them since they are unable to attend Mass during the pandemic.
10. We will evaluate this Phase prior to considering bringing Communion to those who are not family members.
11. No one can currently bring Communion to the Nursing Homes or Hospitals.
12. Please do not approach with any exceptions. The aim is to make sure that our elderly are as safe as possible while receiving the Lord.

Blessing of Renovated CCD Building on August 30th

The Former CCD building has been renovated under Fr. Matthew's leadership and is ready for use. We will bless this building after 10:30am Mass on Sunday, August 30, and will name it The Mount Carmel House in honor of the Carmelite Sisters who taught faith to our grandparents. The building will allow sanitizing norms and us to have small group meetings, as we follow physical distancing. Neither this building nor any other area is ready for Bereavement Ministry gatherings or gatherings where food and drinks are served.
