Dear Friends,

Let us make the month of October a month of *real family prayer*. I encourage all of you to keep a special intention that you want the Blessed Mother to intercede for you throughout the month of October, and to recite the Rosary. Let's also keep a second intention for the end to COVID-19.

Pandemic and Rosary

At the beginning of the Pandemic, Pope Francis wrote about the need for families and individuals to pray the Rosary: "*Contemplating the face of Christ with the heart of Mary, our Mother, will make us even more united as a spiritual family and will help us overcome this time of trial.*" St. Josemaria Escriva teaches us that: "*The Holy Rosary is a powerful weapon. Use it with confidence and you'll be amazed at the results.*" Pray the Rosary!

How to Pray a Family Rosary

- Personalize it: Each family member should have their own Rosary. Children may play with it. Girls may wear it as a necklace. Boys will try to use it as a lasso. That is fine. It helps them become familiar with a Rosary. Eventually they will learn and grow in reverence for their Rosary.

- Create a habit: Set a time that is comfortable for your family and that works without adding stress. When it does not happen, do not give up entirely, just pick it up again the next day.
- Create a space: Set the tone for prayer so young children understand this is different than other family activities. If possible, light a candle and play some soft, background, instrumental music.
- Start small: Be patient. Do not try to complete an entire Rosary the first time you gather in prayer, particularly if you have young children. Start with a decade and build over time.
- Keep it simple: The Rosary is a great way for young children to learn the Hail Mary, Our Father, and Apostle's Creed, and to learn about the lives of Jesus and his Mother Mary.
- Involve all family members: If children have a role, they will participate more fully and be more attentive. Let them lead a reflection or the prayers depending on their age.
- Opportunity to teach: Use the Rosary as a starting point to teach children about other aspects of their faith. Children are curious and will ask questions. Pause in prayer as necessary to answer their questions. As they get older, you can hold their questions until prayer is complete.
- Just start: There's no time like the present and no place like home.
