How to Make this Thanksgiving a Real Celebration of Thanking God

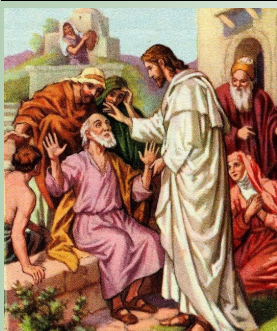
Marian Consecration
