### Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord

#### Holy Triduum

The word *triduum* comes from Latin roots, meaning “the three days” because it starts on the evening of Holy Thursday and lasts until the evening of Easter Sunday.

#### **Holy Thursday**

The Triduum begins on the evening of Holy Thursday. Holy Thursday is when we commemorate the Last Supper that Jesus shared with His disciples, during which He instituted the Eucharist as His true body, blood, soul, and divinity, and instituted the sacrament of the priesthood. Our Celebration will take place at St. Jules Church at 7 pm with the Mass. Adoration will last until 10 pm.

#### **Good Friday**

Good Friday is the day we celebrate the crucifixion and death of Jesus. It is a day of fasting, during which Catholics not only abstain from meat, but only eat one full meal and two smaller meals the entire day. There is no Mass or celebration of the Eucharist on Good Friday. Though Mass is not celebrated, parishes have a Good Friday liturgy, during which there is a reading of the Lord’s Passion and the Veneration of the Cross. Another way that many commemorate Good Friday is with the **Stations of the Cross**. These are a 14-step devotion that walk through the events that took place on Good Friday – beginning with Jesus being condemned to death and ending with His placement in the tomb. Walking Way of the Cross will take place at 7 am from St. Elizabeth Church to St. Jules. There will be Way of the Cross at St. Elizabeth and St. Jules at 9 am. Celebration of the passion of the Lord will take place at 3 pm at St. Elizabeth.

#### **Holy Saturday**

On Holy Saturday, we commemorate the day that Jesus descended into hell. After nightfall on Holy Saturday, the Easter Vigil is celebrated. The Easter Vigil is the first official celebration of Easter, and it is rich in its symbols, rites and readings. Holy Saturday Vigil will be at St. Elizabeth at 8 pm.

#### **Easter Sunday**

Easter Sunday is when we celebrate Christ’s resurrection from the dead. St. Paul tells us in the letter to the Corinthians, *‘if Christ has not been raised, your faith is vain; you are still in your sins. Easter Masses will be at 7:00 am and 8.30 am at St. Jules Church and 10.30 am at St. Elizabeth Church.*
