Easter Sunday the Resurrection of the Lord

Do you believe that Jesus really Rose from the Dead?

Wish you and your families a Happy Easter. May the Risen Lord give you blessings in abundance.

What prompts you to believe in the resurrection of the Lord?

First, we believe because both Scripture and empirical evidence tell us of the Resurrection. Through Scripture, we know Christ was born. Christ was crucified. Christ died. And Christ is Risen. The First Gospel ever written was that of Mark. It was written just five years after the Resurrection. First Letter of St. Paul to the Thessalonians was written in 52 A.D. and Paul narrates the resurrection. Early scripture as well as secular writing talk about an Empty Tomb. If the Resurrection were NOT true, then there would have been no reason for them to write about it.

Second, the first witnesses of the Resurrection were women. According to the Jewish tradition, women’s witness was not strong. In fact, the code of law disallowed women’s witness. So, if the Resurrection was just a story and not true, then why would Scripture writers write about women seeing Christ? Because they KNOW Christ was Risen.

Thirdly, in Scripture, people actually MEET Jesus after the Resurrection. St. Paul says he met the Lord on his way to Damascus. Prior to his conversion, St. Paul was a persecutor of the Lord. So, I ask, why would someone who was a persecutor say he met the Lord? Because he REALLY DID meet the Lord.

Empirical evidence: today, over a billion people believe in Christ’s resurrection. Now I ask you: why would a DEAD leader have such a following? Because he is NOT dead. Because Christ has Risen, and He is living. Even the greatest leaders in our time - Martin Luther King Jr, Gandhi – despite their greatness do not have such a following simply because they are dead and not risen.

May you not only understand the truth of Resurrection but may experience the living Lord in your life.
