### Third Sunday of Easter

Jesus Christ is risen Alleluia, Alleluia!

As we continue hearing the readings from the Acts of the Apostles, we see the rapid growth of the very first Christian community through evangelization, I thought now would be a good time to speak on that subject.

WHO and HOW are we evangelizing in our small community of St. Jules and St. Elizabeth? When we allow the separation of catechesis from the Church's mission of evangelization, it results in challenges for many later in life, both in their relationship with God and the Church. If we are only focused on retaining doctrine, we are limiting ourselves and the opportunities to come to know God personally and the ability to integrate faith and life in order to **truly** live the faith. It is very important to be educated and knowledgeable in our faith in order to share it with others. We don't need to be highly intelligent. All we need is true solid knowledge of our Catholic faith. A good Catholic Christian must assist others in developing good habits and skills in order to live the Christian life. Our primary responsibility, then, is to promote and cultivate the possibility for encounter with God in times of prayer, in moments of fraternity, and when God's Word is being studied. This is especially important when speaking to the young people in our community because it can be hard to connect with them due to our age difference. They may not see us as a true friend and could be easily offended if they feel we are not speaking to them with sincerity and out of true concern for them. If we don't show them true love, it will be hard for them to open up to us about vices or other things in their lives that they are confused about. The young people are the future of our Church Community. It is very important to earn their trust in order for them to grow in their own faith life.

By example in everything we do, through the grace of God and the Holy Spirit, we can help others to encounter Jesus and to choose to live as He did. There is nothing in life that can bring more joy than helping others grow deeper in their relationship with God, truly knowing, serving, and loving Him!
