### Forth Sunday of Easter

#### Rosary for the month of May, Pentecost and Corpus Christi Solemnities

The month of May is dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. We will recite the Rosary at the Church 30 minutes prior to all Masses. On Wednesdays we will have Rosary at 6 PM at St. Martin Chapel.

This year we will celebrate Pentecost on May 23, and the Feast of Corpus Christi on June 6.

Pentecost, called the Birthday of the Church, concludes the Easter Season. We need to be proud of our mother Church. Pentecost reminds us of our responsibility towards the Church. It's a time for us to ask for the gifts and fruits of the Holy Spirit to envelope us.

One of the most important feasts of the Church is Corpus Christi, also called The Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. This truth of the Real Presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist is celebrated at the Feast. This Feast and its truth distinguish us from other Christian denominations. This truth needs to be accepted, witnessed, and proclaimed in our lives.

#### Pentecost Celebration: May 23: Wear Red

To be true followers of Christ and follow his commandment of go to the end of the world and proclaim the gospel, I am asking each one of you to bring one person back to Church. That person can be members of your family or any one whom you know. Studies have shown that most of the time an invitation by a member of church is what it takes someone to return to Church. As you know, it is not your influence that makes the person to return to church, but it is the Holy Spirit that touches the hearts of the people that makes someone turn to Christ. Hence, prayer and your sacrifice for that person is especially important.

We will have a 9-day Novena to the Holy Spirit starting on Friday, May 14. The Novena will be sent out on Flocknote. We will intensify the prayer with 40 hours of Adoration, Saturday, May 22 beginning at 7:00am. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed at St. Elizabeth, St. Jules and St. Martin at the same time and will conclude at 8:30pm at St. Jules and St. Martin, and at 9:00pm at St. Elizabeth. A sign-up sheet will be sent out via Flocknote.

It is my hope that all families will spend at least an hour of Adoration on this day. An intention box will be placed at the foot of the Altar where you can place your special prayers. I ask all of you to bring flowers to the churches on Friday, May 21. We ask families to light candles in front of the Blessed Sacrament for your intentions. Candles can be purchased at the Church itself. There will be a reception after all Masses the weekend of May 22-23.
