Sixth Sunday of Easter

Each one brings one to Church on Pentecost.

To be true followers of Christ and follow his commandment of go to the end of the world and proclaim the gospel, I am asking each one of you to bring one person back to Church. That person can be members of your family or any one whom you know. Studies have shown that most of the time an invitation by a member of church is what it takes someone to return to Church. As you know, it is not your influence that makes the person to return to church, but it is the Holy Spirit that touches the hearts of the people that makes someone turn to Christ. Hence, prayer and your sacrifice for that person is especially important.

We will have a **9-day Novena to the Holy Spirit starting on Friday, May 14**. The Novena will be sent out on Flocknote and will be available on our website. We will intensify the prayer with **40 hours of Adoration, Saturday, May 22 beginning at 7:00am**. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed at St. Elizabeth, St. Jules and St. Martin at the same time and will conclude at 8:30pm at St. Jules and St. Martin, and at 9:00pm at St. Elizabeth. A sign-up sheet will be sent out via Flocknote.

It is my hope that all families will spend at least an hour of Adoration on this day. An intention box will be placed at the foot of the Altar where you can place your special prayers. I ask all of you to bring flowers to the churches on Friday, May 21. We ask families to light candles in front of the Blessed Sacrament for your intentions. Candles can be purchased at the Church itself. There will be a reception after all Masses the weekend of May 22-23.

At the weekend Masses both deacon and I will pray over people.

Wear Your Mask and Return to Mass: Bishop Duca



Bishop Duca's slogan moving forward is "Wear your Mask and Return to Mass". Bishop Duca in his letter on May 3, said "I have decided that we will keep the mandate of wear masks and begin to lessen the physical distancing as more parishioners return to church". As for our parish I have opened 75 percent of our pews and have kept 25 percent of the closed for those who still want to be socially distanced and feel comfortable. We will have sanitizers available in the Church. Church will be sanitized after every Mass.

The Bishop has lifted the **Dispensation from Obligation to Attend Sunday Mass** is lifted from June 6, 2021. This means anyone who is physically able is obligated to attend Mass. However, the Bishop clarified that if you are not comfortable because you have not yet got vaccinated due to lack of vaccines, you can make your personal choice of attending or not attending the Mass.

We can have meetings with Masks indoors. However, there will be NO receptions or meetings with food served in doors. We are not able to have wakes in the Church yet.
