Dear Friends,

On this Pentecost, The Birthday of the Church, let me announce a few new things we intend to do at our parish to support our parishioners to become active in the Church. The early Church grew by leaps and bounds because people worked as one in mind and heart for the glory of God.

St. Elizabeth and St. Jules Catholic Education Scholarship 2021-2022

St. Elizabeth and St. Jules Catholic Churches are proud to announce new Scholarship opportunities available to our parishioners. Up to 10 scholarships per year will be awarded (8 for PK3 – 8th Grade and 2 for 9th-12th Grade). Monetary awards will range from \$250 to \$1,000.

To qualify for this scholarship, you must meet the following eligibility requirements:

Must be REGISTERED at St. Elizabeth or St. Jules Catholic Church and must be a practicing Catholic family. This means you must attend Mass weekly and have active participation in the church (tithing or volunteering of time).

Must have a child registered at St. Elizabeth Catholic School from Prek3 – 8th grade. We will also award 2 high school scholarships to those who attend local Catholic high schools (9th-12th). Children who hold an active ministry in the Church will be given preference (Altar servers, lectors, ushers).

Must be able to provide proof of income for needs-based acceptance.

Complete and submit an application **by June 20, 2021**. Applications are available on our website and parish office.

Youth Choir

We would like to start a Youth Choir immediately. The Youth Choir will include children from 4th Grade to 12th Grade. We invite youth and young adults who can sing or play any instrument to this group. There will be regular practice for choir members. We would officially start the Youth Choir on August 15 at 10:30am Mass. Those interested please contact the office.

Bible Study

We will begin a Bible Study Program in August. There will be two sessions on Thursdays: one in the morning and a repeat session in the evening. This will be led by Deacon Erhen and me. To make it a productive study, we need at least 10 people enrolled in each session.
