Volunteers for Parish Office

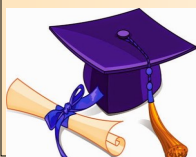

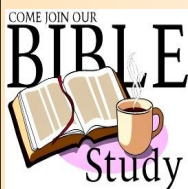
