Dear Friends,

First, let me thank all of you who attended the Eucharistic Procession. The weather was perfect. It was a 4 hours 40 minutes procession. I was able to go around our parish boundaries praying for all of you. God's grace is going to be pour out on us. Thank you for all who helped to organize.

Following is our 2021-2022 PSR and Sacramental Program. [Forms on website]

The purpose of the PSR /Religious Education Program is to instill in students and families the need to practice faith, which parents and godparents took upon themselves on the day of their child's baptism. The focus of this year's Religious Education Program is to bring students and their families to the celebration of the Eucharist and other Sacraments.

To achieve this end, all students are expected to attend weekend Mass. Students in Grades 2-11 are expected to complete a form that will be available at the entrances of our churches. The forms will also be available on our parish website (www.sesjchurch.com). The questions on the form will be concerning the weekend Masses. Students can sit in the church and fill the form for 5 to 10 minutes after the Mass and place the form in a box provided at the entrance of church.

On the First Sunday of the month there will be a class for students and parents in the Church following the 10:30am Mass. During that time: Parents of students in grades K-10 will be expected to attend a short class. Grades 3-10 students will remain with their parents for the class while K-2 students will be taken by the Sisters. The duration of the class will be 25 to 35 minutes. All students will have to attend at least an hour of Adoration on any one of the first Fridays. Students also have to participate in the way of the cross during Lent. This method is called Intergenerational Catechesis. This method is being utilized in many parishes across the country.

Candidates need to complete 25 service hours. Ten hours of the 25 hours will be being ministers at the Mass. Other 15 hours can be done preferably with the Church such as Food Bank, cleaning the church etc.

Special requirements for High School Students

Students in Grades 9,10 & 11 will be expected to serve as Mass Ministers: Usher, Lectors, Youth Choir or Altar Servers

Students in Grades 7 & 8 are highly encouraged to participate in Mass ministries. There will be special training for them and will be added to the schedule of ministers.

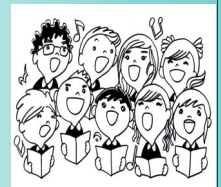
Apply for a Scholarship
