Duties of parents towards their children in the practice of faith

We live in a society where individual choices are given much importance. Today a 4th grader can decide if he wants to eat or not. He chooses what he wants to wear. So too he can say if he wants to go to church or pray or even be part of the family prayer. All in the name of individual choices. According to the law of the land children under 18 are still considered children and hence parental guidance is expected. Hence the Catechism of the Catholic Church (Articles 2221 to 2226) gives the following guidelines to the parents.

2221 The fecundity of conjugal love cannot be reduced solely to the procreation of children but must extend to their moral education and their spiritual formation. "The *role of parents in education* is of such importance that it is almost impossible to provide an adequate substitute." The right and the duty of parents to educate their children are primordial and inalienable. 2222 Parents must regard their children as *children of God* and respect them as *human persons*. Showing themselves obedient to the will of the Father in heaven, they educate their children to fulfill God's law. 2223 Parents have the first responsibility for the education of their children. They bear witness to this responsibility first by *creating a home* where tenderness, forgiveness, respect, fidelity, and disinterested service are the rule. 2225 Through the grace of the sacrament of marriage, parents receive the responsibility and privilege of *evangelizing their children*. Parents should initiate their children at an early age into the mysteries of the faith of which they are the "first heralds" for their children. They should associate them from their tenderest years with the life of the Church.

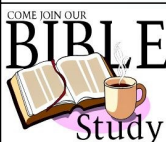
