Dear Friends,

We are in a new academic year and our children are back to school. Our parish is ready to start all its activities once again. However due to a surge in Covid-19 cases in the state of Louisiana once again we are restricted with what we can do. The governor has once again imposed a mask mandate in all indoor gatherings. Bishop Duca has given some guidelines to follow. Given the seriousness of the situation these guidelines are necessary to keep everyone safe.

I know everyone loves one's freedom but one's exercise of freedom can not infringe the freedom of others to live happily. Selflessness is a virtue that we need to exercise currently. Let us not lose hope but let us fix our eyes on the Cross from where life flowed through blood and water. His selfless act of giving up his life gave us Life eternal.

Following will be the changes we have to adopt for the safety of everyone.

1. Mask wearing is for all indoor gatherings in the Church premises including Mass except for little children.
2. Church and Hall will be sanitized after all gatherings.
3. You are encouraged to socially distance in the church and hall.
4. Those who are uncomfortable to come to church for any reason can use our FM Radio 90.9 to participate in the Mass from the parking lot.
5. There will be no Mass or Adoration in the Convent Chapel but will be in the church.
6. Youth and adult choir practice and singing at Mass is postponed until further notice.
7. Wake in the church is possible provided family can ensure people wearing masks.
8. There will be no bereavement after funerals or any receptions in the halls.
9. Bible study, youth sodality, religious education program and all other meetings of groups will go on as planned.

Anger or anxiety is not what we need. We need caution and a sense of other centeredness now. It is the time for us practice the great saying in the Bible "Obedience is better than sacrifice" (1 Samuel 15. 22).

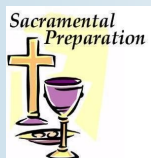
