### Origin of Fatima Prayer

The Fatima Prayer was brought about when Mary appeared to three shepherd children during May 13th through October 13, 1917 in Fatima, Portugal.

The Mother of Jesus' purpose for these visits was to save souls from Hell and to warn us of the coming tragedies that would happen if we didn't repent and change our ways. Mary wanted to remind us of the so-called Four Last Things: Death, Judgment, Heaven, Hell.

If you keep in mind that these four last things are just as certain as death and taxes, surely you will strive to live a holier life so that you will make it to Heaven.

The Catholic Rosary prayers will help you live a more holy life.

After showing the children Hell, Mary expressly asked for the Fatima prayer to be recited.

She said, "Each time you say the Rosary, My children, say after each decade, "O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of Hell, lead all souls to Heaven, especially those most in need'." This has become known as "The Fatima Prayer".
