The Baptism of the Lord

THE EFFECTS OF BAPTISM

SINS FORGIVEN

By Baptism all sins are forgiven, Original Sin and all personal sins, and temporal punishment due to sin is removed. After one has been reborn in Christ, there is nothing to prevent one's entry into God's Kingdom.

ADOPTED CHILDREN OF GOD

Baptism also gives us new life as adopted children of God. We become sharers of divine life and temples of the Holy Spirit. Our permanence in the state of grace is called sanctifying grace because God "sanctifies" us, that is, makes us his holy people by giving us his life. Actual grace helps us mature in goodness through the practice of virtues, such as the Cardinal Virtues: prudence, justice, temperance, and fortitude.

INITIATED INTO THE CHURCH

By Baptism we become members of the Church, the Body of Christ. We share in the priesthood of Christ as well as his prophetic and royal mission. We enjoy the community we find in the Church, share our talents and gifts with its members, respond willingly to its teachings and requirements, and assume the responsibilities that our membership implies.

BONDED TO OTHER CHRISTIANS

Baptism provides a common foundation among all Christians, including those not yet in full communion with the Catholic Church. The Church recognizes the validity of Baptism in other Christian Churches as long as the rite involved the pouring of or immersion in water, a Trinitarian formula, and the intention to baptize.

BAPTISMAL CHARACTER

"Incorporated into Christ by Baptism, the person baptized is configured to Christ. Baptism seals the Christian with the indelible spiritual mark (character) of his belonging to Christ. No sin can erase this mark, even if sin prevents Baptism from bearing the fruits of salvation. Given once for all Baptism cannot be repeated" (CCC, no. 1272).

Immediate Purpose of the Event:

What you are going to experience at this transcription will be similar to what many millions of monks experienced in transcribing the Bible for centuries; a complete peace in reading, writing and understanding the scriptures.

End Purpose of the Event:

The transcribed chapters of the Bible chapters will be bound as a Bible and will be taken to all the parishes of Assumption Civil Parish and will be presented to the Bishop in view of the 60th Anniversary of the diocese.

When you sign up, you will be sent a chapter of the New Testament which you will write on January 23. You can go through the chapter and pray with it before you come to write the chapter on January 23.

Event:

1. Arrive for the Mass not later than 10:15 am. Carpooling is highly encouraged.
2. You will be provided with paper and pen to write.
3. It should not take more than 1. Hour for you to write one chapter
4. No food or beverage permitted in the hall.
5. Your name will be published in the Bible.
6. The event will be in a total atmosphere of silence.
7. After you have transcribed the chapters, you will be asked to write the verse that was most meaningful to you.
8. After the event, refreshments will be served
