Always Address the “so what?” Question

- The tradition, doctrines, scripture and heritage we possess sit in a vacuum if they are not connected with real life experiences
- There is always a “why” behind each teaching of the Faith
- These are the most important things to explain to our youth because that is when true learning happens. They are able to connect it with a reason instead of just being told what to do
- Don’t pass up opportunities to address these questions. If left unanswered, the lesson will be forgotten by the kids by the time they get into the car to go home!
- If you don’t the “why” behind a teaching, just ask! None of us are perfect to have each answer but that’s why we are called to community with those around to help each

Use this story after the opening prayer, before explaining that it is important to tell the truth.

Chapter Story: It's the Truth

Some famous quotes of former presidents tell of the importance of telling the truth. Benjamin Franklin said, "Honesty is the best policy."

George Washington is given credit for the quote, "I cannot tell a lie." Legend says that when he was asked if he had chopped down a cherry tree, this was his reply.

James A. Garfield said, "The truth will set you free." The less famous full quote, however, is "The truth will set you free, but first it will make you miserable."

- **Read aloud the story.**
- **Invite the children to write a saying about the importance of telling the truth.**
- **Ask: Why do people sometimes not tell the truth?**
- **Transition back to the lesson instruction.**

Read scripture passage

Ask the What do you wonder questions.

Witness to the Truth

Ask: How do people show they value truth? Write answers on a poster board or a small white board.

Read about St. Thomas More

- **Ask the children the questions listed in the margin**

A martyr is a person who gives up his or her life to witness to the truth of Christ.

Discuss some Catholic martyrs from the catechist background section on pg. 211

Speak and Act the Truth

- **Read paragraphs**
- **Ask why Thomas More and others were willing to give up their lives to witness the truth.**

The Eighth Commandment (pg. 212)

- **Ask: What does the Eighth commandment call you to do?**
- **Read the paragraphs and discuss who is my neighbor.**

- **Read the paragraph.**
- **Read scripture verse and discuss what Jesus meant when he said “the truth will set you free.”**
- **Read the paragraph.**

The Gossip Monster is defeated!




