HELPFUL HINT OF THE DAY

8 Tips for a Better Lent

1. Pray and slow down – spend 10 minutes a day in prayer

On a Mission

The word mission comes from a Latin word meaning “to send” and includes the idea of being sent to accomplish specific tasks. Some missions are simple. For example, you may be given the task of cleaning your room, or your teacher may send you to find paper supplies for your group.

At other times, your mission may be more serious. You might be sent to a neighbor’s house to help watch young children or be asked to deliver an important message to a parent or teacher.

You will have many different types of missions in your life, but none are as important as spreading the Good News.
