

## Confirmation Service Hours

Sharing our gifts and talents with the community through service is a crucial aspect of what it means to be Catholic. Service opportunities are intended to give candidates positive experiences, along with opportunities to put their faith into action. All Confirmation candidates are asked to participate in service opportunities throughout their Confirmation preparation (and ideally, then, throughout their lives!).

For that reason, we require our Confirmands to perform **5 hours of service per year** within St. Albert Church or the Sun Prairie community before you are confirmed. That comes to a total of **10 hours** of service over the two years of Confirmation preparation.

A service hour is one hour of your time that you volunteer. You should not get paid or be compensated in any way. You may begin “counting” your service the summer after 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grade year.

### Potential service opportunities:

Volunteer at the Sunshine Supper.

Volunteer at the Mobile Food Pantry.

Help serve at Luke House (the 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday of every month).

Serving as a liturgical minister: Join the choir, volunteer to be a reader, hospitality minister, or altar server for the Sunday liturgies.

Volunteer as a high school leader for middle school Youth Ministry events.

Help with special events such as Vacation Bible School, serving at the Christmas Cantata, or helping with Albertfest.
